The responsibility of the Health and Nutrition coordinator will be the implementation and coordination of the Humanitarian assistance project aimed to be implemented in vulnerable IDP populations in Yei, South Sudan.

Main responsibilities:

- Coordinate and technically monitor the implementation of all project activities according to the objectives, indicators, work plan and approved budget
- Ensure regular and proper project documentation and reporting according to donor and Malteser standards, rules & regulations (interim and final reports, monthly reports).
- Facilitate trainings and sensitization sessions at the community level and ensure the development of community feedback mechanisms
- Support the CEFoRD nutrition officers in undertaking the field activities and document findings and recommendations of field visits for follow-up actions; shares as appropriate
- Develop and put into practice appropriate and cost-efficient monitoring tools to improve the nutrition and hygiene situation with regard to expected results and indicators as in mentioned in log frame, work plan and other relevant project documents
