The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position based in Juba.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:

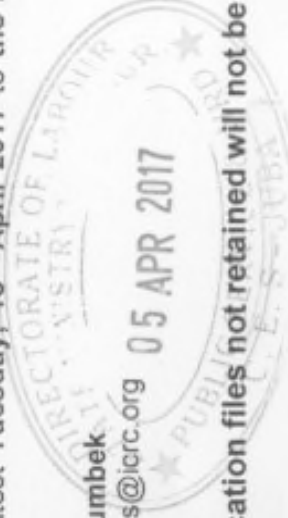
- In view of the current crisis; main tasks relate to relief response including assessment, implementation and monitoring of relief activities i.e. food, essential household items and fishing kits.
- Facilitates relief and market related options: Identification of needs and geographical areas in collaboration with Sub-Delegations / Juba and implementation of EcoSec activities in the field with the help of the EcoSec Delegate.
- Advice and support EcoSec Team with the implementation of agro, livestock, and fisheries based small-scale livelihood support Initiatives.
- Design and contribute to the implementation of relevant emergency interventions.
- Provides regular updates to Line Manager on FS related issues particularly the impact of displacement and conflict on the livelihood, livestock, agriculture, fisheries, people's coping mechanisms and vice versa in the program location
- Investigates the real capabilities of the private and government in terms of overall economy and relief sectors
- Maintains a clear record/ trail of financial advances issued to the field officers updating reporting line manager and ensuring timely clearance of cash advance
- Get involved in development and implementation of relief, agro, livestock and any livelihood related projects in various states wherever appropriate
- In close collaboration with relevant local authorities and humanitarian actors in the field, implement relief, agro and livestock programmes ;carries out general EcoSec assessments ;undertakes post distribution monitoring;participates in market surveys and household / community economy assessment and analysis

Minimum Required Knowledge & Experience:

- 'A' Level (Higher/Advanced Higher Grade exam) or equivalent. Some college coursework completed or an Associate Degree is an asset.
- Additional vocational training in a humanitarian area, socio-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or equivalent field
- 3-5 years of experience in a humanitarian area, socio-economic development,
- Conversational in English and Arabic
- Advanced level in computer skills (Excel and Word)
- Skilled in the following competencies:; Analysis & Synthesis, Planning & Organizing, Adapting & Learning; Communication (ability to express and exchange views and ideas); Representing the ICRC
- Good knowledge of ICRC mandate, IHL, and of other humanitarian topics
- Good knowledge of geographically assigned environment
- Readiness to spend 50-75% of the time in the field
- Driving License; Succeeded in ICRC Driving test.
