JOB ADVERTISEMENT PHYSIOTHERAPIST Based in Ganville

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above-mentioned position working in Ganyliel, ICRC Sub-Delegation Bentiu.

Objectives of the function

The physiotherapist is responsible for implementing all physiotherapy-related activities from the acute to the early rehabilitation stage, fulfilling various roles to lead in the promotion, improvement, and maintenance of people's oblifty, health and well-being.

— He assesses and provides services to patients in need of physiotherapy within the ICRC hospital program in Ganiyel during emergency and non-emergency situations.

The physiotherapist works under the supervision of the Hospital Project Manager.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assesses the patients and creates treatment plans accordingly.
- · Carries out the physiotherapy treatment according to the treatment plan.
- Recognizes problem / complications during the implementation of the treatment plan and act and informs the right person accordingly.
- Participates in the (final and regular) evaluations / discharge and ensures that instructions (including maintenance and use of appliances) are understood by patient / family.
- Organizes the follow up in the treatment if objectives are not yet reached (Out Patient Department).
- Create optimal circumstances for the patients as well as workplace.
- Actively participates to the hospital rounds as full member of the multidisciplinary team.
- Participates to the weekly/general cleaning of the physiotherapy department and wards as hygiene is detrimental in decreasing the risk of infections.
- Contributes in statistics and other reports.
- May support and contribute in lectures and demonstrations within trainings / presentations as required.
- Follow up on physiotherapy patients referred to other health care facilities (e.g. PRP).

Minimum Required Skills and Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in physiotherapy, or technical diploma with 3 years' full-time training, with a valid licence to practise in South Sudan
- Additional relevant degrees (e.g. public health, hospital acute techniques) are an asset.
- Registered Physiotherapist in South Sudan and meet professional continuing education requisites.
- Minimum 1 year of postgraduate experience and up-to-date knowledge.
- Experience in Hospital or Physical Rehabilitation Centre preferred.
- Experience with the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement and/or in multicultural environments or low-resource settings are strong assets.
- Fluent in English and preferably Arabic. Speaking Nuer is an asset.
- Skilled in the following competencies: Team Work, Planning, Organization & Assessment.
- Understanding of and motivation for ICRC's mandate.
