FIRST-AID FIELD OFFICER
Based in Juba

The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), an impartial, neutral and independent organisation striving to protect and assist the victims of war and internal violence, has been working in South Sudan since 1986. The ICRC is looking for an enthusiastic and motivated person for the above position to be based in Juba.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Supports development and implementation of a comprehensive plan for First-Aid (FA) trainings, working with state and non-state arms carriers to raise the profile of ICRC and identify priority groups for FA training;
- Ensures that all participants to a FAT receive a certificate and the first aid kit accordingly;
- Requests training materials and FA kits, ensuring donation certificates are completed and signed by all concerned;
- Assists the Health Delegate to identify, through field activities and interlocutors, allegations of Health Care in Danger (HCiD), in close collaboration with Field Delegate.
- Is aware of the Sub-delegation's objectives and has a good knowledge of the Movement, Local SSRC branch, and other humanitarian organizations.
- Together with the Health Delegate, conducts FA training for identified groups (Arms carriers, community) which focuses on development, use and maintenance of First-Aid methodology, meeting local needs and reality (as outlined in the FA Strategy document).
- Assists the Health Delegate to coordinate referral of patients for ICRC Physical Rehabilitation Program (PRP), actively promoting the service within the local community.
- In coordination with the Health Delegate, liaises with South Sudan Red Cross Society (SSRCS) representatives in regard to First Aid Trainings and other Health and First-Aid related activities.
- Contributes to fostering a positive relationship between the ICRC and SSRCS branch in relation to current and emerging health issues.
- Applies the security rules at all times

Minimum required knowledge & experience:

- 'A' Level (Higher/Advanced level exam) or equivalent.
- Medical profession/background with South Sudan registration and public health experience. preferred
- Recognised certification in a professional field such as health, socio-economics, water, sanitation and hygiene, community development, communication, social sciences, law, etc;
- 2-3 years of experience in humanitarian work (health, socio-economic development, humanitarian law, human rights or similar position highly recommended) and thorough knowledge of South Sudan Health System;
- Good level of written and spoken English and Arabic;
- Knowledge of other local languages such as Kakwa, Moro, Dinka, etc. will be an added advantage;
- Good level of computer applications especially Word, Excel and Power-point;
- Willingness to learn and adapt;
- Readiness to spend most of the time in the field.
