Position Title: Roving Protection project Manager

Report to: Executive

Duty station: Juba/frequent visits to field sites.

Contract Duration: 4 months renewable subject to availability of fund and acceptable performance.

General Context of Project

South Sudan is a country that has been affected by both natural and conflict-related emergencies for five years. Mobile Humanitarian Agency (MHA) is a National non-governmental organization operating in Southern Unity implementing protection monitoring/assessment activities through community based-protection mechanism in the hard-to-reach areas/Islands.

MHA is seeking a Roving Protection Project Manager that will manage staff based in Leer, Mayendit and Juba and potentially other areas within South Sudan in future. S/he will be required to travel regularly to field sites and some overnight stays in locations other than the base location may be required. Occasional work at weekends may be required.

Scope of work

Under executive director's guidance and supervision, the Roving Protection Project Manager will be responsible for implementation of protection components of projects, including line-managing staff, directly implementing protection activities under this grants. In addition it is expected that the Roving Protection Project Manager will ensure that all grants for which s/he is focal point are implemented in a manner that ensures the highest accountability standards for internal partners, beneficiaries and donors. The role of the Roving Protection Project Manager will also involve coordination, oversight and coaching of the protection team in technical aspects of implementation. The Protection Project Manager will ensure that all work plans are prepared and implemented according to schedule

Responsibility & Task

- ❖ The assessment/evaluation, analysis and monitoring of the current and anticipated needs and resources and identifying a suitable response.
- ❖ Developing/contributing to the program strategy appropriate to MHA's strategy and the program context.
- ❖ Monitoring and review of the program's progress, relevance, and efficiency, and adjusting activities and processes as needed.
- ❖ Communications - internal and external, security, policy and negotiations, and contracts and law.
- ❖ Coordinating with other partners, humanitarian organizations and Government entities.

- ❖ Assess protection risks and implement mitigation strategies for both host and IDP communities.
- ❖ Continuously monitor conflict situation in order to track conflict trends and identify protection needs.
- ❖ Design and implement protection interventions appropriate to context and need within parameters of mandate and projects
- ❖ Identify and flag communities or individuals in need of specialized support services, maintain updated referral pathway through field staff and ensure effective dissemination of information
- ❖ Establish and support community protection mechanisms, provide technical skills training in conflict analysis, nonviolent conflict resolution and community based protection strategies.
- ❖ Monitor all protection issues and coordinate with concerned local authorities and NGOs to ensure that relevant protection partners are fully informed on the situation in the location
- ❖ Organized and facilitates workshops and training at the field level for protection staff and partners.
- ❖ Development of the concept note and proposal writing
- ❖ Attending cluster and Sub-cluster meeting and meeting donors as well.
- ❖ Compile monthly project report and share with respective cluster/sub cluster

4. Qualification and requirement

LLM or Bachelor degree in Law from recognized University or Social Science and other relevant qualification, with minimum of 4-5 years' work experience implementing protection programming including experience in emergency.

Demonstrate experience in human rights, GBV and Child Protection

Demonstrated successful experience in working in complex security environments

Demonstrated ability to live, work and solve problems independently and effectively in remote, highly challenging locations.

Strong computer skills and knowledge of GMS (grants management system will be advantage

Good communication skills written and verbal as well as culturally sensitivity
