TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR SMART SURVEY IN JUBA COUNTY (JUBA RURAL), 2018

Background

ART is a national non-governmental organization working to bring hope and development to the people of South Sudan. ART is implementing Health, Food Security, Nutrition, and protection programs in the country in various locations. ART's nutrition program supports the management of children under 5 years with Severe Acute Malnutrition without medical complications in 16 OTP sites. ART provides nutrition services in Juba county. The current nutrition program which is supported by UNICEF commenced in April 2018 and ends in March 2019.

The Pre-Harvest SMART nutrition survey for Juba rural has been planned to be conducted this year 2018 between September and October, under the current nutrition PCA with UNICEF which shall end by March 2019.

SMART Survey Justification

Goals: The Overall objective of the SMART assessment is to Estimate the current prevalence of acute malnutrition among children 6-59 months of age as well as underlying risk factors contributing to malnutrition such as morbidity, Infant and Young Children feeding (IYCF) practices and estimate retrospective mortality rates of all persons who live in Juba rural, Jubek State, South Sudan.

Specific Objectives of the survey

- 1. To estimate the prevalence of morbidity among children 6-59 months in the last two weeks prior to the survey date.
- 2. To estimate the proportion of the nutrition/health program coverage.
- 3. To estimate measles vaccination and Vitamin A supplementation proportion.
- 4. To establish the prevailing Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) Practices.
- 5. To estimate the prevalence of acute malnutrition (Global and severe) among children aged 6-59 months in Nasir and Juba Rural, Jubek State, South Sudan
- 6. To estimate retrospective crude mortality rate (CMR) and under five mortality rates U5MR) in the entire population of Juba rural, Jubek State, South Sudan
