SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

Samaritan's Purse is looking for a qualified individual(s) to work as a **relocatable clinical officer**. The clinical officer's key responsibility will be for the day to day management and oversight of the TB/ART center. This position works directly with the Health Program Manager and Medical Doctors in maintaining standards, resolving problems and assisting in implementing change in order to provide quality services to patients.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Contribute to the overall delivery of care at the hospital
- Responsible for daily ward rounds in the TB/ ART center; as frequent as the patients' conditions demand
- Assist with out-patient consultations
- Prepares and submits weekly, monthly and quarterly TB/ART reports and other relevant reports to the Health Program manager, and as directed.
- Offer hands – on clinical instruction to nurses during ward rounds
- Must be available to assist the nurses with difficult procedures.
- Requisitioning and accounting for TB/ART equipment, supplies and medicines
- Supervising and appraising TB/ART staff
- Adhering to professional and service code of conduct and ethics
- With a generous and serving spirit perform all other tasks & responsibilities assigned for the benefit of Samaritan's Purse (SP)
- Always document all relevant information pertaining to the care provided to the patients and share the same with other health care members involved
- Attend to patients and staff spiritual/ emotional needs as appropriate
- Actively participate in continuous medical education sessions
- Attend and actively participate in staff meetings
- Maintain a clean ,tidy ,safe and healthy work environment

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- Diploma in clinical medicine from a recognized institution.
- Secondary school certificate
- Additional training and practice in health care management including HIV/AIDS and counseling will be an added advantage.
- At least two years of related work experience with NGO community and public health programs based at a well-established medical health facility/ project.
- Prior experience in public health work in the local communities of South Sudan is desirable.
- With a generous and serving spirit perform all other tasks and responsibilities assigned for the benefit of Samaritan's Purse.
- Fluency in English and Arabic required
- Ability to write and speak in English and Arabic
- Fluency in Maban is preferred
- Ability to work in a hostile environment with only basic necessities
