Introduction

INTER SOS is an independent no-profit humanitarian organization committed to assist the victims of natural disasters and armed conflicts. INTER SOS was established in 1992 with the active support of Italian Trade Unions. INTER SOS activities are based on the principles of solidarity, justice, human dignity, equality of rights and opportunities, and respect for diversity and coexistence, paying special attention to the most vulnerable and unprotected people. INTER SOS identifies with the core values of the Italian Association of Non-Governmental Organizations and adheres to the international humanitarian codes of conduct and to the values and principles expressed in these codes. INTER SOS is recognized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the European Commission and the main UN Agencies. It enjoys the consultative status with the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) of the United Nations. INTER SOS was created to provide an effective response to crisis situations in the unprivileged regions of the world, where the population is deprived of their rights and dignity and their basic needs are uncovered.

INTER SOS will be implementing a project 'Life-saving WASH support and preparedness for vulnerable IDPs and host communities affected by violence and are at risk of Cholera in Kapoeta East County of Eastern Equatoria State'; The overall objective of the project is to: "Provide life-saving WASH intervention to people affected by recent conflict and at risk of cholera". INTER SOS would like to hire qualified and experienced project staff for this project implementation.

The **WASH Project Manager** will be based in Narus, Kapoeta East with frequent field trips to project locations in Natinga and Lokaleen area. He/she will be responsible for the quality of INTERSOS' interactions with the local communities, ensuring strong relationships and promoting community ownership of all INTERSOS activities related to water, sanitation and hygiene in the communities and schools where the project will be implemented. The WASH PM is responsible for activities planning together with the WASH team and Supervision of the WASH Officer and hygiene officers and the community Hygiene promoters. He/she is also responsible for Technical maintenance of WASH Infrastructure. He/she is also responsible for conducting trainings for communities and schools on hygiene, Water Management Committees, Hygiene promotion and Awareness campaign, Data collection, Developing the new concept ideas and Mobilizing the schools and communities for WASH activities in conjunction with the WASH State Cluster as necessary.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure coordination and implementation of WASH Cholera response
- Be responsible for implementation of the WASH project according to the signed Agreement and further modification approved by the donors- mainly SSHF funded.
- Be responsible for conduction of baseline, consultation with local NGOs for target area selection, developing reports (interim and final)
- Be responsible for the timely submission of cholera preparedness and activities reports to WASH Cluster/ Cholera response focal point organization;
- Be responsible of the preparation of all the accounting documents, including tender and procurement for intermediate and final financial reports required by donors.
- Ensure a steady and active representation of INTERSOS at cluster level as well in all the other, significant meetings (i.e. cholera response coordination meeting in Kapoeta).
- Maintain daily relationship with the Donors and involve the NFIs/WASH Program Coordinator whereas strategic opportunity can arise.
- Maintain ongoing surveillance of the developing humanitarian situation, cholera outbreak in particular and adjust activities accordingly.
- Supervise and monitor the construction of WASH infrastructure and implement soft component as envisaged in the project proposal.
- Coordinate with health partners managing CTC/CTUUs/ORPs and local authorities in Kapoeta East.
- Provide WASH technical guidance to health partners responding cholera cases.

Required Qualifications and Skills:



- Must be a South Sudan National with at least Diploma or University Degree in Civil Engineering, Water Resources Engineering or Environmental Engineering or relevant experience in the same field. Post Graduate Qualification in the similar field is an added advantage.
- A minimum of three years' experience in WASH, preferably with humanitarian organization in a related field.
- Knowledge of Computer aided design and Microsoft Office
- AUTOCAD, ARCHICAD, MS Excel, MS Word and MS Power point
- Language: English is mandatory
- Strong humanitarian commitment
- Quality: dynamic, autonomous, Proactive, flexible, take initiative.
- Fluency in English and knowledge of local language is an asset
- Availability to work in Kapoeta East, Eastern Equatoria State.
