Terre des Hommes Foundation (Tdh) is an international NGO focussed on Child Rights. To support the development of its **projects in Yei, Lainya and Juba**, Tdh is encouraging applications from South Sudanese nationals for the role of:

Health and Nutrition Officer *SO. H 3*

Duty station: JUBA with frequent travel to Yei and Lainya County

Contract duration: 6 months (with possibility of renewal)

Starting Date: ASAP



Purpose of the position

The Health and Nutrition officer's role is to plan, implement, monitor and report on Health and CMAM activities within TDH's health and nutrition program in Lainya County. This shall be done in collaboration and close consultation with the Health and Nutrition Project Manager, Yei Field Coordinator, Country Director and relevant stakeholders including SSUHA, county health authorities in Yei and Lainya County.

Main responsabilités

- Support the implementation of TDH's Health and Nutrition project ensuring strict adherence to protocols and program quality for better results.
- Build the capacity of Health Facilities and Mobile Clinics staff, Community Health workers, and SSUHA staff through training, mentoring, supervising and regular engagement.
- Support the Health and Nutrition Manager to develop monthly activity work plans in line with MOH action plans and the commitments in the respective donor proposals.
- Ensure a strong monitoring system is in place and that program data on key health and nutrition indicators, including program coverage, community participation, health and nutrition knowledge and practice, is collected, analyzed, reviewed and responded to on an ongoing basis.
- Regularly report on program outcomes, activities, processes and lessons learned to inform the internal TDH as well as donor.
- Support CHWs in planning and clearly outlining the quantities and specifications for all required health and nutrition materials well in advance and liaising with the logistics department to ensure details and timelines are well understood.
- Ensure effective training and mentoring of Health Facility Staff and community level (Community Health workers) in community health & nutrition program activities and monitoring, as applicable.
- Ensure sufficient stocks of health and nutrition supplies for both MAM and SAM interventions are in place, liaising with UNICEF and WFP to ensure no stock outs at the health facilities.
- Contribute to the development of project proposals/concept papers for key donors and their budgets
- Promote actively among staff, communities, and external stakeholders, the crosscutting issues
- Carrying out other related duties as assigned by the Health and Nutrition project Manager.
- Participate in country-level strategic planning initiatives and other duties as determined by line

management.

- Participates in internal coordination meetings as needed and requested.
- Participates in external coordination meetings (Cluster meetings, meetings with health authorities) and ensures the correct technical coordination of TDH health and nutrition activities.
- Represents TDH in the relations with the Ministry of Health in Juba, Lainya and Yei.
- Ensures the correct integration of TDH's Health and Nutrition activities and strategy in the Ministry of Health's plans, policies and regulations.
