ABOUT THE GRAIN INDUSTRY EXPERIENTIAL TRADE MISSION

Each year during the month of May, EAGC organizes a trade mission and a grain industry experiential visit to South Africa for the Agribusiness sector players from the Eastern Africa region and beyond. The objective of the mission usually is to expose the value chain actors to best international practices in agribusiness sector on technology and innovations. The mission is held during the same week as the annual NAMPO Show, which is the biggest agricultural show in the southern hemisphere showcasing latest technologies, innovations and also highly discounted agricultural equipment and machinery sale. These include: promoting agricultural production in the context of climate change. Post-Harvest Handling. commercial agricultural commodity marketing as well as high level deliberations on favorable policies that would be key towards promoting competitiveness within the sector and reducing the cost of doing business. Participants also get an opportunity to interact with South Africa's commercial grain farmers, traders and processors at their facilities where they get exposure to interact and exchange experiences amongst them.
