Organizational background

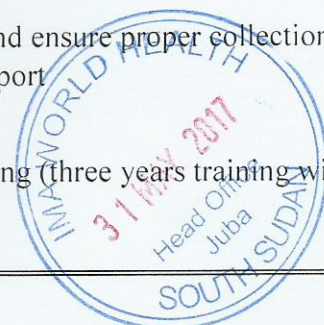
IMA World Health is seeking to recruit nurses based in Pochalla Hospital. S/he will ensure the successful operation of the RRHP II Project. Provide support to other Nursing staff in Pochalla Hospital in coordination with the clinical officer and CHD Director.

Essential Functions:

- Registration, and taking vital signs of patients presenting at clinic
- Health education session to patients waiting to be seen.
- Monitoring of patients who are severely ill and require stabilization prior to transfer including management of intravenous fluids. Overseeing all administrative aspects of referral and ensuring family and community are informed and supported.
- Dressing and follow up of patients requiring regular dressing
- Injections required at the clinic
- Assisting dispenser by working as a dispenser in pharmacy, preparing medication and explaining to patients how medication should be taken.
- Assess, plan, develop, implement and evaluate programs to promote health and well-being of the patients
- Implement and evaluate individual treatment plans for patients with a known long term condition.
- Identify and manage as appropriate treatment plan for patients at risk of developing a long term condition.
- Prioritize health problems and intervene appropriately to assist the patient in complex, urgent or emergency situations, including initiation of effective emergency care.
- Support patients to adopt health promotion strategies that encourage patients to live healthily and apply principles of self-care.
- Provide information and advice on prescribed or over the counter medication on medication regimens, side effects and interaction.
- Support the community health workers to conduct community based health education and awareness session on relevant topics such as malaria, TB etc.
- Support the facility staff to maintain proper records of all consultations and ensure proper collection of data for weekly integrated Disease Surveillance Responses monthly report

QUALIFICATIONS:

Qualified registered Nurse/Midwife from a recognized school/institution of nursing (three years training with a Diploma. A BSc degree is added advantage



EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS:

- Minimum 1-3 years working experience of relevant professional experience in Primary Health Care, Nutrition, outreach, vaccination and acute watery diarrhea/cholera management.
- Strong understanding of community, cultures and customs
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to work as part of a team and demonstrate flexibility, motivation and maturity.
- Ability to work in a stressful and changing environment with limited resources
- Willingness to live and work with basic amenities
- Able to recognize and respect confidential matters
