

JOB VACANCY: Extension Assistants (5)

Aim of the position:

The Agriculture Extension Worker will technically support AVSI Foundation Food Security and Livelihood (FSL) activities and especially the planning, organization and implementation of the targeted goals and Objectives of FSL projects, the planning and organization of Monitoring activities and technical trainings and providing on job training to the agriculture community facilitators.

Job Description:

- Ensure that Agriculture and Food Security outputs meet project objectives and are aligned with International best practice and consider cross cutting issues such as gender and sustainability;
- Establishment, in coordination with the CAD, of APFS as per project requirements and continuous follow up;
- Support the beneficiary targeting, registration and distribution of emergency livelihood kits following an agree selection criteria.
- Ensure appropriate support to the field sites for progressive farmers' groups, alternative livelihood groups through regular visits;
- Collaborate/facilitate in the on-job training in Agriculture and Food Security, and support project implementation for community groups;
- Collaborate/facilitate in the on-job training in Agriculture and Food Security, and support project implementation for community groups and extension workers Monitor
- Write weekly reports on project activities (distribution, post distribution monitoring etc...)
- Coordinate with relevant partners (farmers group, County Agriculture Department, local authorities)
- Coordinate and attend kits distribution as per project requirement;
