RESPONSIBILITIES

The midwife Instructor is responsible for providing Clinical instructions for maternal and Child Health interventions that promote activities within Rumbek hospital and Community.

Report when needed and represent IRC in key meetings with different stakeholders at the community level.

MAIN DUTIES:

The midwife Instructor is responsible for providing Clinical instructions to the community midwives. This includes:

- Provide Clinical instructions to the community midwives to ensure quality maternal and Child Health services.
- Promotion of Safe Motherhood (Ante natal care, post-natal care, STIs/HIV, Post abortion care, obstetric care and family planning).
- Promotion of Gender Equality in the community and assist all person victims of gender inequality
- She/he will work with other members of the mobile clinic team (CO, Nurse, Midwife/MCHW, dispenser, nutrition team, WPE team, etc.) in the planned community activities.
- She/he will promote, maintain and improve individual and community health by assisting individuals and communities to adopt healthy behaviours. Collect and submit data to the CO who will identify community needs prior to planning, implementing, monitoring, and evaluating programs designed to encourage healthy Approvide and Pulsed to State Musiky of labour and Pulstic Service, lifestyles, policies and environments.
- Community Based Tasks:

- Provide health education, promotion of health activities as organized and planned with respect of confidentiality
- Update health education topics and propose new health topics to be taught in the community
- Educate community with a diversity of IEC materials and develop other related to the need.
- Organize meetings with community representatives, and target groups as needed.
- Promote integrate gender and women health right in the community

Mentors and coordinates:

- Active input to the work plans based on the given trends and needs of the population.
- Active participation in the regular Health and RH/GBV meetings.
- Provide mentoring and specific capacity-building for the staff including specific management skills as well as broadening skills in technical areas (case management, psychosocial support, referral mechanism, community-outreach and awareness-raising)

Monitoring & Reporting:

- Record and report weekly all health education/promotional sessions (site, number, gender, age).
- Compile data/reports and share with the CO when required.
