Job title: Social Worker
Reporting to: Case Supervisor
Location: Juba
Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

The Social Worker will be responsible for identifying children with psychosocial support needs, development of case management and therapy plans and the provision of Level 3 psychosocial support to identified children through age and gender-appropriate modalities, including individual, family and groups. The Social Worker is responsible for case file management and follow up on each child case, including medical checks, education enrollment/attendance, social reintegration.

Major Roles and Responsibilities.

- Lead in case management and provision of age and gender appropriate PSS for children and GBV survivors, including development of PSS/Counselling plans, confidential case file management, case follow up and referral to other services (clinical, education etc)
- Lead Family Tracing & Reunification (FTR) case management, in collaboration with FTR monitors and tracing teams, to facilitate reunification, provision of PSS for UASMs/releases children, case follow up, case file management, referral to additional services (clinical, education, social reintegration, economic reintegration services,)
- Supervise CFS site by establishing weekly/monthly activity plans with age and gender appropriate activities, ensure full time operations according to agreed schedule ensure CFS





is fully equipped and equipment is maintained; supervise activity implementation; provide on-job coaching and mentor-ship to animators/community volunteers to strengthen their ability in provision of Community based PSS and PFA, supervise community volunteers at Child Help Desks.

- Capacity building of government social workers, teachers, PTA members, SMCs, community leaders and other partners as necessary in Community based PSS or basic PFA
- Weekly updates, monthly reporting to Protection Coordinator, Project Manager; Input to M&E frameworks as necessary (indicator tracking, CPMIS, GBVIMS, etc) in collaboration with Information Management Officer

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Diploma / Certificate in Social Work, Psychology, Behavioral Studies, Counselling or similar required
- Certificate courses in UNICEF PSS Guidelines, Psychological First Aid, Community-Based PSS, MHPSS coursework is preferred
- Work experience in Social Work, Child Psychology, FTR Case Management, GBV Case Management, Comprehensive Case Management for children of concern
- Must have strong working understanding of rights-based approaches that support and protect the best interests of children
- Working knowledge and understanding of GBV survivor-centred approach is strongly preferred
- Must have a love for children and demonstrate patience, tolerance, problem solving, open-mindedness and interest in social justice.
- Basic written / speaking English strongly preferred
- Local language as first language strongly preferred
