# **Project Summary:**

## **Project Background:**

The MELS activity serves as the Mission's primary mechanism for monitoring, evaluation, and learning and adaptive management services for ongoing activities and programs. In a dynamic operating environment, MELS provides USAID/South Sudan with flexible, demand-driven technical, analytic, and advisory support in order to strengthen collaboration, learning and adapting (CLA); promote institutional memory; produce monitoring, evaluation, learning products as appropriate; strengthen knowledge management and organizational learning (KMOL), organizational effectiveness and operational efficiency; and strengthen data-driven decision-making through an efficient use of GIS and other innovative spatial analysis.

#### **Position Summary:**

The Senior M&E Manager will be responsible for managing the implementation of MELS monitoring and evaluation functions including all reporting functions. S/he will also be responsible for collection and analysis of performance metrics for USAID/South Sudan's activities. The Senior M&E Manager will report directly to the Deputy Chief of Party (DCOP).

# Responsibilities:

- Support the implementation of USAID/South Sudan's Performance Management Plan (PMP) including the
  design of data collection tools and techniques in collaboration with technical staff ensuring compliance
  with ADS201.
- Develop protocols for data collection ensuring standard operating procedures and ethical standards in data collection and reporting.
- Conduct on-site monitoring of USAID/South Sudan's activities collecting both qualitative and quantitative data including monthly spot checks to ensure data have been accurately collected from program beneficiaries and client-directed data quality assessments.
- Assist in the generation of reports, data tables, graphics, maps, and other visual tools/aids that support USAID activities and results for required deliverables as well as for special meetings where data are required for decision making.
- Provide training to staff, partners, and other relevant stakeholders on M&E systems, policies, procedures, data collection techniques, and performance monitoring.
- Assist in providing concise, summarized reporting against indicators for quarterly and annual progress reports.
- Assist the Deputy Chief of Party with documentation and presentation of MELS activities and results.
- Supervise M&E Specialists and ensure quality and timeliness of their work.
- Perform any other activities as assigned by the Deputy Chief of Party.
