About CMMB

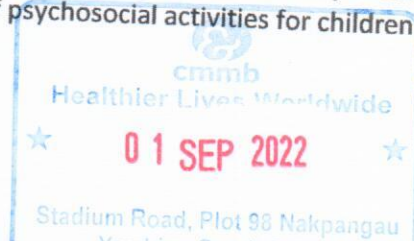

CMMB provides health services through a two-pronged approach namely (i) facility based and (ii) community-based services that promote health seeking and health sustaining behaviors to reduce morbidity and mortality among the most vulnerable, women and children. 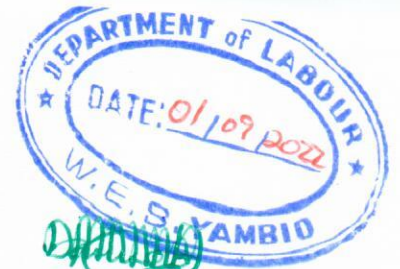

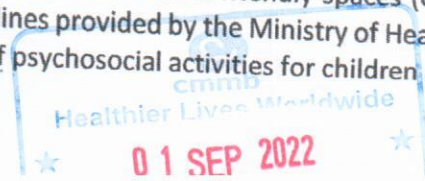

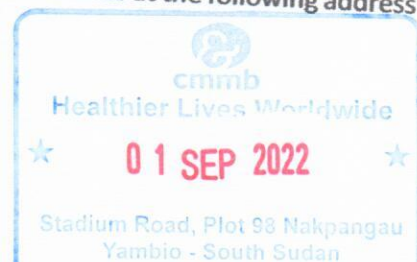
