In doing so, we aspire to include and build the capacity of local organizations, communities and authorities. HealthNet TPO strives for developing evidence-based interventions to strengthen the health of populations in distress.

With funding from HPF, HealthNet TPO in Consortium with Impact Health Organisation (IHO) will support CHDs of Gogrial East, Gogrial West and Twic Counties in delivering of essential health care services across supported health facilities and in the communities of the three Counties.

The purpose of the Job:

The PHC Supervisor as part of the HealthNet TPO team South Sudan and he/she will directly supervise all primary health care activities in all the counties of lot 18. He/she will be responsible for direct supervision of primary health care services, capacity building of the health facility staffs, county health departments and ensuring provisions of quality health services while maintaining effectiveness and efficiency of all project activities at the county and facility level. The primary health care supervisor will work under the supervision of the Lot manager.

Main Responsibilities:

- Work in collaboration and coordination with the CHD and other stakeholders to ensure effective and efficient implementation of PHC activities as guided by the Basic Package for Health and Nutrition Services guideline.
- Together with the CHD team, plan and carry out supervision and support visits to the health facilities (PHCCs and PHCUs) aimed at identifying gaps and opportunities for improving the quality of service delivery at the primary health care level.
- Ensure that the quality of maternal and neonatal health services and immunization services at all levels of care is up to date with the BPHNS required standard of South Sudan.
- Ensure that nutrition, GESI, and EPI are integrated in primary health care services at all levels of care in the 3 counties.
- Support in the establishment of the health structures at the county, Payam, Boma and facility level and ensuring that these structures remain functional so as to stabilize the community health systems.
- Support the CHD in human resource management including recruitment of staffs, establishment and maintenance of the HRIS system, development of staff JDs, timely preparation of the SSEPS payrolls
- Key EPI focal person for the Lot and will coordinate all EPI activities with the CHD/SMOH, IPs and health facilities.
- Organize for routine weekly, monthly and quarterly quantified supervisions to all the health facilities within the Lot and follow up for the improvement of the identified gaps.





- Together with the M&E, organize for the quarterly review meetings, quarterly technical reporting and follow up for the implementation of the agreed action points.
- Provide administrative and logistical support to the CHDs and health committees in organizing outreaches
- Represent HealthNet TPO in different forums while adhering to the confidentiality ethics of the organization.
- Perform any other responsibility as assigned by the supervisor

- Qualified health professional with a degree in medicine and nursing or a diploma in clinical medicine, nursing and midwifery with at least three years of working experience.
- Demonstrated ability to work with the CHD, Local authorities and partners.
- Must be registered with the health professional body and have a valid practicing license.
- Able to demonstrate ability to write quality reports
- Fluency in English and Arabic, Knowledge of local language would be an added advantage
- Proficiency in computer applications for office use; MS Excel, power point and other MS Office products, good presentation skills.
