# Organizational Background

South Sudan Network of PLHIV (SSNeP+) is an umbrella of State Networks, member associations and support groups of people living with HIV and AIDS, in South Sudan. SSNeP+ as guided by its constitution of 2007 Non-governmental organization registered in South Sudan by RRC and supported by Global Fund

#### **Position Overview**

The Finance Manager will lead financial strategy, compliance, and operations to ensure SSNeP+ delivers impactful programs while maintaining accountability to donors, government authorities, and beneficiaries. This role requires expertise in NGO financial management, donor compliance, and adaptability to South Sudan's complex operating environment.

### **Key Responsibilities**


#### 1. Financial Planning & Budgeting

- Develop and monitor annual organizational budgets aligned with strategic goals.
- Collaborate with program teams to create project-specific budgets for grant proposals.
- Track cash flow and ensure liquidity for operations in a volatile financial environment.
- Conduct monthly variance analysis and advise leadership on corrective actions.

# 2. Accounting & Reporting

- Oversee day-to-day accounting processes (payroll, receivables, payables) using OuickBooks or similar software.
- Prepare accurate, timely financial reports for internal, stakeholders and external donors (e.g., quarterly Global Fund reports).
- Ensure compliance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) and South Sudan NGO regulations.
- Maintain a robust filing system for audits and accountability.

#### 3. Grants & Donor Compliance



- Manage financial aspects of grants (Global Fund, PEPFAR, etc.), including disbursements, reporting deadlines, and allowable costs.
- Conduct pre-audit reviews to ensure adherence to donor guidelines.
- Liaise with donors to resolve financial queries and facilitate audits.
- Train program staff on grant compliance and budget vs. actual expenditure tracking.

### 4. Audit & Risk Management

- Coordinate annual external audits and implement audit recommendations.
- Prepare statutory reports for the South Sudan Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (SSRRC) and Ministry of Finance.
- Mitigate risks related to fraud, currency exchange fluctuations, and banking instability.
- Update internal control policies (e.g., procurement, petty cash) to safeguard assets.

## 5. Capacity Building & Team Leadership

- Mentor a team of finance officers and accountants to strengthen institutional capacity.
- Train non-finance staff on budgeting, expense reporting, and compliance.
- Foster a culture of transparency and accountability across the organization.

### 6. Strategic Financial Leadership

- Advise the Executive Director on financial sustainability, cost-recovery models, and diversification of funding.
- Develop contingency plans for economic shocks (e.g., inflation, donor withdrawal).
- Represent SSNEP+ in financial discussions with partners, government, and donors.

 Masters degree in Finance, Accounting, or Business Administration (Master's degree or CPA/ACCA preferred, Chartered Institute of Purchasing and Supply (CIPS) will be added advantage

### **Experience**

- Minimum 10 years in financial management, with at least 5 years in NGOs or humanitarian sectors.
- Proven experience managing large grants of UN agencies
- Familiarity with South Sudan's tax laws, NGO regulations, and banking systems.
- Experience working in post-conflict or resource-limited settings.

### **Technical Skills**

- Advanced proficiency in accounting software (QuickBooks, Sage) and Excel.
- Strong grasp of donor compliance frameworks (e.g., PEPFAR's financial rules).
- Fluency in English (written and spoken); Arabic or local languages are assets.
