Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

- ❖ **The pharmacist will be in charge of all activities related to the medical warehouse management of Rumbek State Hospital. He/ she will be responsible for the development, coordination and supervision of all related activities, according to the rules and regulations of South Sudan, national and international regulations and law.**
- ❖ **Ensure smooth drug and medical equipment procurement and supply, efficient processes and procedures of medical warehouse management, transportation, storage and handling of medical devices to guarantee availability of required drugs and to avoid oversupply or stock shortage of drugs.**
- ❖ **Collect and analyses relevant data and indicators of stock management (level of stock, alerts for**
- ❖ **low stock levels, oversupply, expirations etc.) and ensure orderly documentation.**

- ❖ **Technical advice regarding all pharmaceutical information, appropriate use of drugs, side-effects etc.**
- ❖ **Support budget planning and procurement of drugs and other medical material and equipment in cooperation with the Hospital Management.**
- ❖ **Ensure appropriate storage of narcotic and psychotropic drugs in line with national legislation as well as their traceability.**
- ❖ **Ensure safe disposal of drugs and medical products according to relevant rules and regulations.**
- ❖ **Support and represent-the Hospital vis-a-vis the Ministry of Health and other local authorities as well as local and international suppliers regarding the provision of pharmaceuticals and medical equipment to ensure the availability of required drugs.**
- ❖ **Actively Promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within International Medical Corps and amongst beneficiaries served by International Medical Corps**
