

ROLE PURPOSE:

The post holder will be responsible for the mobilization of the community and facilitation and their engagement in the smooth implementation of the food security and livelihood component of the ELRP project in Kapoeta North. This will be achieved by working with and supporting the FSL officer in carrying out food security assessments, community mobilization, identification of target beneficiaries, and facilitation of community-level meetings and monitoring at the lower level.

KEY AREAS OF ACCOUNTABILITY:

- Help plan and carry out activities with the community to implement food security and livelihood interventions.
- Participate in the gathering of data during needs assessments, baseline surveys, and other assessments.
- Work with the relevant local authorities and experts in settings the beneficiary targeting and selection criteria for FSL interventions.
- Keep a daily record of Save the children materials and resources used in the field.
- Collect and record routine activity data and share it with the supervisor.
- Ensure the work plan relates closely to the regularly updated project work plan guiding the project implementation and progress toward completion.
- Prepare action plans jointly with project staff and local government and other stakeholders for monitoring, review, and periodic project reporting.
- Act as a link between the community leaders, the community, and the stakeholders.

- Ensure timely completion of project activities according to the weekly and monthly plans.
