POSITION DESCRIPTION

This position for the MOMENTUM Integrated Health Resilience (MIHR) project, led by IMA World Health, the post will report to the County Project Officer, based at the County Health Department. MIHR will recruit and assign one FP/RH/MNCH Officer per supported health facility with experience and expertise in FP/MNCH and who will be supplemental to existing staff and serve to model, coach, mentor, ensure quality care, accurate reporting, and adherence to US Government's FP and PLGHA legislative and policy requirements. The FP/RH/MNCH Officer works closely with the Community Strengthening Liaison as part of the facility QI team to support ongoing discussion of FP/RH/MNCH gaps in facility and community levels.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide on-site clinical mentoring and coaching to FP/RH/MNCH care providers including provision of quality FP/RH care, based on need.
- Data collection and analysis and use by facility and community teams
- Oversee QI in MCH and support ongoing QoC in facilities
- Adhere to protocols and SOPs and oversee adherence by other health care workers
- Supervise child outreach workers (CHWs)
- Facilitate joint solutions, filling gaps at facility and community levels
- Maintain cordial relations with government and other partners, staff, clients, and the community



- Performs all other related duties involved in the family planning service provision as assigned or required.

REQUIREMENTS

- Nurse or clinical officer with experience as a family planning provider
- Hands on experience in a setting that provides FP/RH care (e.g. post-abortion care, IUD services)
- Must have at least five years of experience in a clinical setting
