Job Title: Research Data Assistant x 3 (Family MUAC)
Reporting to: Research Coordinator
Location: Central Equatoria
Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

The purpose of this job is to collect data for surveys of children and caregivers for an evaluation of the use and adaption of family mid-upper arm circumference (MUAC) within child nutrition programming. The evaluation is part of a study nutrition programming adaptation to COVID-19 being carried by World Vision and partners. The evaluation is built upon surveys of children and their caregivers over 14 months within the catchment areas of WV child nutrition programmes.

Survey data collectors will be members of an evaluation team (in either Upper Nile or Central Equatoria region), led by an evaluation co-ordinator. They will participate in training and planning for several weeks before starting surveying. They will be expected to be carrying out surveys for several weeks at a time, 4 to 5 weeks of intense daily data collection in the field, followed by 1 to 2 weeks in the office for reviewing, planning, refresher training.

Survey data collectors will be in direct contact with children their caregivers, carrying out measurements of children and interviewing caregivers. They are critical to the success of the study as they are directly responsible for the quality of the data being collected.

Key Job responsibilities

Implementation

- Attend and participate in training and achieve competency in standards of the evaluation
- Follow and adhere to the implementation and ethical protocols of the evaluation
- Enrol evaluation participants
- Conduct interviews with and observations of participating caregivers
- Carry out MUAC measurements of participating children



- Record data according to evaluation protocols
- Safeguard and manage data in compliance with standards of the evaluation
- Ensure that confidentiality privacy, ethical, and safety protocols and procedures are maintained

Coordination

- Liaise with the health facility in charge to ensure adequate supplies to the CNVs.
- Report all issues affecting the research project to the Family MUAC research Coordinator
- Coordinate with fellow data collectors to ensure activities are running smoothly

Reporting

- Provide weekly reports on data collection.
- Reporting all issues affecting the study in a timely manner

Qualifications/Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience.

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- At least a Diploma is in ICT and/or statistical studies
- Technological skills: experience with Android operating system, ability to use PC, and MS Word and MS Excel for basic document writing and spreadsheet creation
- Literacy and numeracy: ability to read, write and count; secondary school diploma
- Excel for basic document writing and spreadsheet creation
- Fluency in the local language of the evaluation area
- Experience with data collection, M&E, survey work
- Experience with ODK-based data collection
- Must be engaging, friendly, and caring of others: able to meet and greet people with ease, show empathy and caring for others, and be friendly and respectful
- Must be diligent: able to follow and respect detailed instructions and quality assurance protocols
- Can keep a high level of energy throughout a long day, a long week, and apply that to supporting other team members
- Loves to play and have fun and enjoys being part of a team
- Can listen carefully and learn quickly
- Basic written / speaking English strongly preferred
- Local language as first language strongly preferred
