Essential Job duties / Scope of Work:

ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES

He/she will be responsible for daily activities in the facilities which among others include:

- Provide clinical care to patients in the hospital (IPD, OPD, Pediatric ward, surgical ward, maternity, medical ward, emergency room, TB isolation room, trauma unit nutrition stabilization center...) and ensure that high quality clinical care is provided to patients at the clinic/ in patient ward.
- Manage all components of the medical practice set-up and ongoing management based on the South Sudan treatment guidelines and protocols,
- Participate in supportive supervision for junior staff and provide on the job training as needed.
- Participate in monitoring the drugs and medical consumables consumption to ensure effective and efficient utilization of medicines and medical consumables.



- Assist the medical Coordinator in preparation of equipment, drugs and medical consumables requisitions. This includes selection, acquisition, training and maintenance to ensure high degree of healthcare delivery.
- Provide leadership and supervise Clinical Officers including assessment of their clinical competence and support for ensuring best practices.
- Review Clinical Officers, Nurses and other clinical Staffs performance regarding adherence to guidelines and protocols to ensure quality of care.
- Maintain highest standards of infection prevention and waste disposal, and ensure that staff is to directly supervised follow IP protocols.
- Comply to IMC Standard Operational Procedures.
- Perform any other related duties that may be assigned by line manager.
