Nutrition Officer Surge- ERT

Duration of the Job: 6 Months

Job Purpose: To implement project activities geared towards achieving nutrition programme objectives of reducing morbidity and mortality through provision of essential nutrition services in any of the states of South Sudan

Key Responsibilities:

- Implement all activities necessary in CMAM programmes including TSFP, OTP, SC, MIYCN / IYCF-E and the community out-reach component activities.
- Provide on-the-job training following national (CMAM and MIYCN) and international guidelines to locally recruited nutrition staff, MoH and other nutrition partners.
- Provide training on, supervise and oversee facility and community based screening for malnutrition in children (6-59 months) and pregnant lactating women.
- Provide training to Community Nutrition Assistants and Volunteers on key IYCF messages at facility and community level as per the National Maternal, Infant and Young Child Nutrition (MIYCN) guidelines.
- Undertake community sensitisation to the local authorities and community leaders to ensure they have a good understanding of Medair's programming and interventions.
- Participate and support conducting of Nutrition Programme assessments undertaken by Medair in the operational area.
- Provide day-to-day oversight in a nutrition site as requested.

Staff Management:

- Assist in supervising locally recruited staff working at nutrition facilities. Supervise the Community Nutrition Volunteers to effectively undertake the Community out-reach component,

Quality Management and beneficiary accountability:

- Undertake weekly site supervision exercise using the national CMAM Monitoring and Supervision Checklist, track the identified gaps (creation of a log book which will show the improvement of the findings), provide feedback to the implementing team and devise mechanisms to address identified gaps.

Reporting:

- Develop and submit required daily and weekly nutrition programme report.
- Compile activity reports as well as monthly Sitrep as delegated.

External Representation:

- Attend nutrition meetings at field implementation level as requested by the Nutrition Manager.
- Refer to the Nutrition Manager/s and Nutrition Project Manager before making any commitment (verbal or written) on behalf of Medair.

Logistics:

- Assist in preparing field orders for approval by the Nutrition Manager/Nutrition Project Manager.
- Help ensure adequate nutrition stocks are available and adequately stored at facility level at all times for patient load.

- Diploma in nutrition, nursing or public health
- At least 2 years work experience implementing health or nutrition programme in emergency context
- Experience in CMAM programming
- Fluent in spoken Arabic, English and written (classical)
- Basic knowledge of MS word, MS Excel, PowerPoint and outlook
