

CIDO is seeking a dynamic and community-oriented **Agricultural Extension Officers** to lead field implementation of Food Security and Livelihoods (FSL) activities in Akobo East. The Officer will bridge the gap between technical agricultural research and the local farming community, facilitating the adoption of improved farming practices to boost production and household resilience.

Key Responsibilities

Mobilize communities and identify vulnerable beneficiaries for project participation in coordination with the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) and local leaders.

Establish and facilitate **Farmer Field Schools (FFS)** and demonstration plots to teach modern agronomic practices. Train farmers on climate-smart agriculture, pest management, and post-harvest handling techniques suitable for the Akobo context.

Supervise the distribution of agricultural inputs (seeds, tools, and fishing kits) ensuring transparency and accountability.

Provide technical support on vegetable production, crop diversification, and flood-recession agriculture and conduct regular field visits to monitor crop performance and identify outbreaks of pests or diseases.

Support the formation of Village Savings and Loan Associations (VSLA) among farming groups

Collect data on project impact (yield assessments, planting surveys) and maintain accurate beneficiary databases.

Prepare weekly and monthly activity reports for the Project Manager.



Qualifications and Requirements

Diploma or Bachelor's Degree in General Agriculture, Agronomy, Rural Development, or a related field. Minimum of **2–3 years** of experience in agricultural extension work, preferably with an NGO in South Sudan. Proven experience in setting up demonstration plots and facilitating adult learning.

Skills & Competencies:

Fluency in **English** is required. Proficiency in **Nuer** (Thok Naath) is explicitly required for this role to communicate with the local population in Akobo. Ability to ride a motorbike in rough terrain (valid license preferred). Proficiency in MS Office (Word, Excel) for reporting.

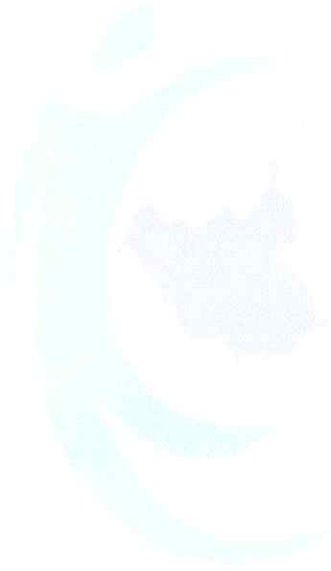
