## **DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The specific tasks of the Driver will be:

- Drive Cuamm vehicles according to the CUAMM Policy
- Drive Cuamm vehicles according to the authorised Project activities plan, to and from any required destination
- Check vehicles conditions regularly (e.g. tyres, lights, fluids, fuel battery etc.), timely signalizing any problem to CUAMM Mechanic.
- Be responsible in full for one of the Cuamm project cars
- Check vehicles condition before any travel
- Check the validity of the vehicles needed documents
- Weekly cleaning/washing of the assigned car (Vehicle and Ambulance)
- Ensure vehicles are fuelled (asking for money to Administrator Assistant), with complete spare parts kit for emergency repairs (to be requested from CUAMM Mechanic) and with a functioning Thuraya (to be requested from the compound Manager)

- Make minor repairs on the vehicles and routine service (oil filters etc.)
- Supervise/follow the service and maintenance done by the mechanic and fill in the vehicle's maintenance book
- Fill daily and maintain vehicle's log sheets
- Be responsible of the loading of the vehicles according to Compound Manager orientations
- Provide regular receipt for each expense done (fuel, spare parts, service ...) to the Administrator Assistant
