Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an independent international medical humanitarian organization providing assistance to people affected by armed conflicts, epidemics, natural or non-natural disasters, or persons excluded from access to health care. The organization has health projects in more than 70 countries.

MSF France has had a significance presence in South Sudan more than 40 years. Currently, MSF runs 3 projects in South Sudan; one in Aweil supporting Aweil state hospital which has more 200 bed capacity (in-patient, OT, ITFC and Maternity) wards to improve management of patients hospitalized and outreach activity. In Akobo, MSF started recently its presence in Akobo provide curative and preventive paediatric services and Toch/Paguir MSF supports PHCC. The Coordination office in Juba provides support to and coordinates all the MSF France projects in Juba.

MSF France is looking to fill the position of **Clinical Officer (15)** based in Fangak County. The successful candidate will report to MSF Medical Doctor.

The objective of the Position:

Organize and ensure medical consultations for patients and/or a target population providing treatment to patients within the scope of his/her medical competencies and referring patients with conditions falling beyond his competencies, in order to guarantee quality and efficiency of the service provided. This will be done in accordance to the context, MSF protocols, procedures and the universal hygiene standards.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Ensure the implementation and standardization of MSF clinical policies, tools, and hygiene protocols in order to minimize clinical risks and to grant quality of patient case management
- Promote and maintain confidentiality regarding all patient cases and records
- Implement diagnosis, prescription and prevention procedures that fall under the scope of his/her competencies applying medical knowledge, asking appropriate questions to patients and
- following protocols in force as well as using laboratory services, when necessary, to ensure a correct implementation of the medical treatments and to refer patients when appropriate.
- Can do nurses activities when needed.
- Attend weekly or others meeting for improvement quality of patients care.
- Participate in planning and supervising, training, evaluation, development and communication of the team to ensure both the sizing and the amount of knowledge required
- , improve people's triage capabilities, their motivation and commitment and their active participation in teaching the targeted population on therapeutic and preventive protocols.

- Record in individual patient's card and registration books all medical activities (drugs prescribed, lab results, vaccination status, epidemiological activity, doses, etc) performed
- keeping data traceability to ensure patients treatment continuity.
- Participate in data collecting and reporting when required
- Know and implement Patient Therapeutic Education (PTE), i.e. keeping contact with all patients, providing them information regarding their health state and responding to their questions.
- Complete other tasks as assigned by team supervisor and manager

- In the ER Carry out proper assesment of the patients using ABCD approach and prescribe treatment according to MSF guidelines.
- In collaboration with the team carry regular review patients under observation in the ER according to their clinical condition example malaria, diarrhea cases etc.
- Ensure adherence to standard infection prevention and control during wound dressing, disinfection of the stethoscope in between and hand gygiene
- Continuity of care; ensure proper bedside side handing and taking over of the patients both written and verbal in between shift.
- Flexibility; provide support to other department in the event increase activity in OPD or difficult case in maternity
- Ensure clear and readeable documentation/hand writing of the patients clinical assesment.
- Adherence to internal regulation; Internal regulations; respect to working schedulle, attending
- regualr meetings and training as per schedule, annual leave planing, security rules etc.
- Patients centered care: provide clear and compassionate communication to the patients/relatives
- regarding procedures, risk, their health status and respond to their question appropriately.

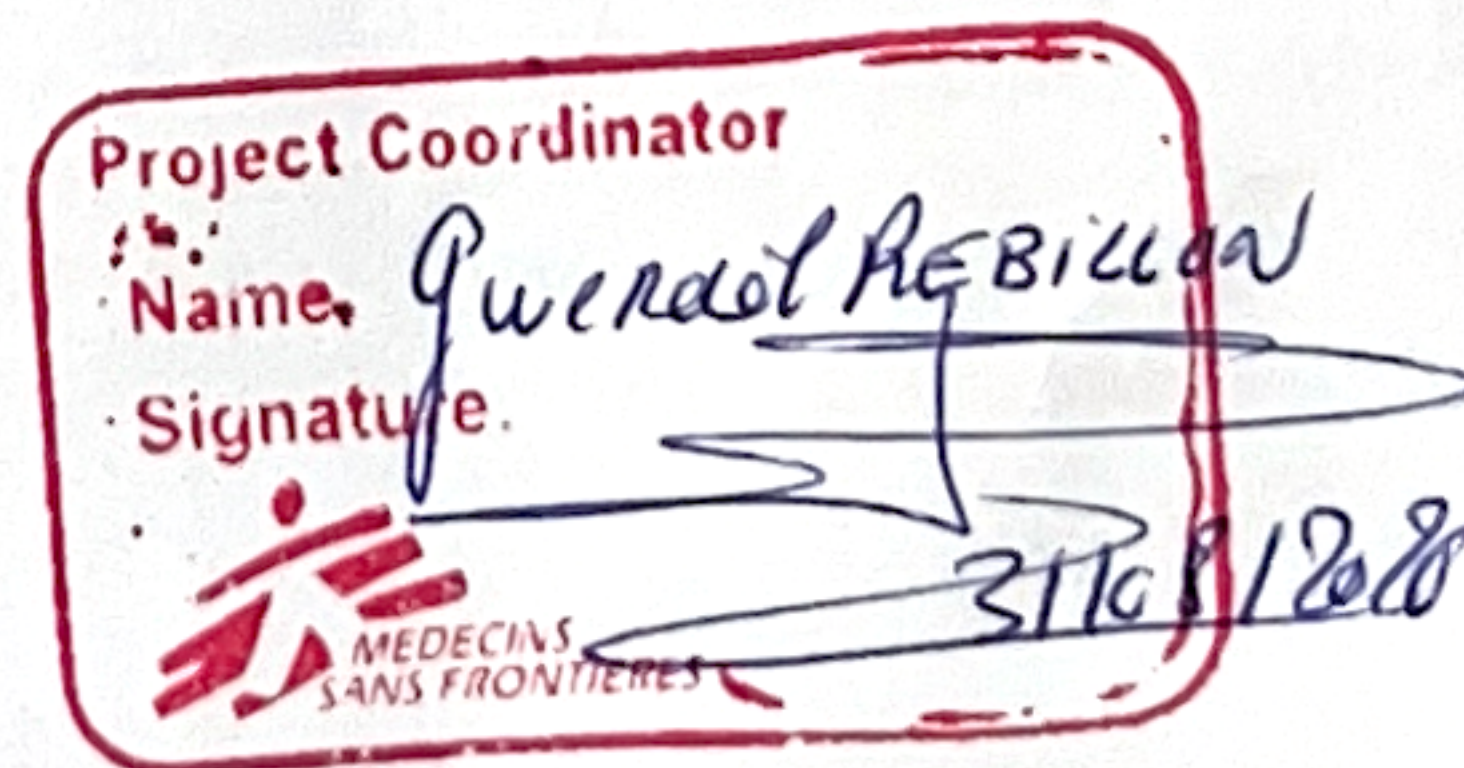
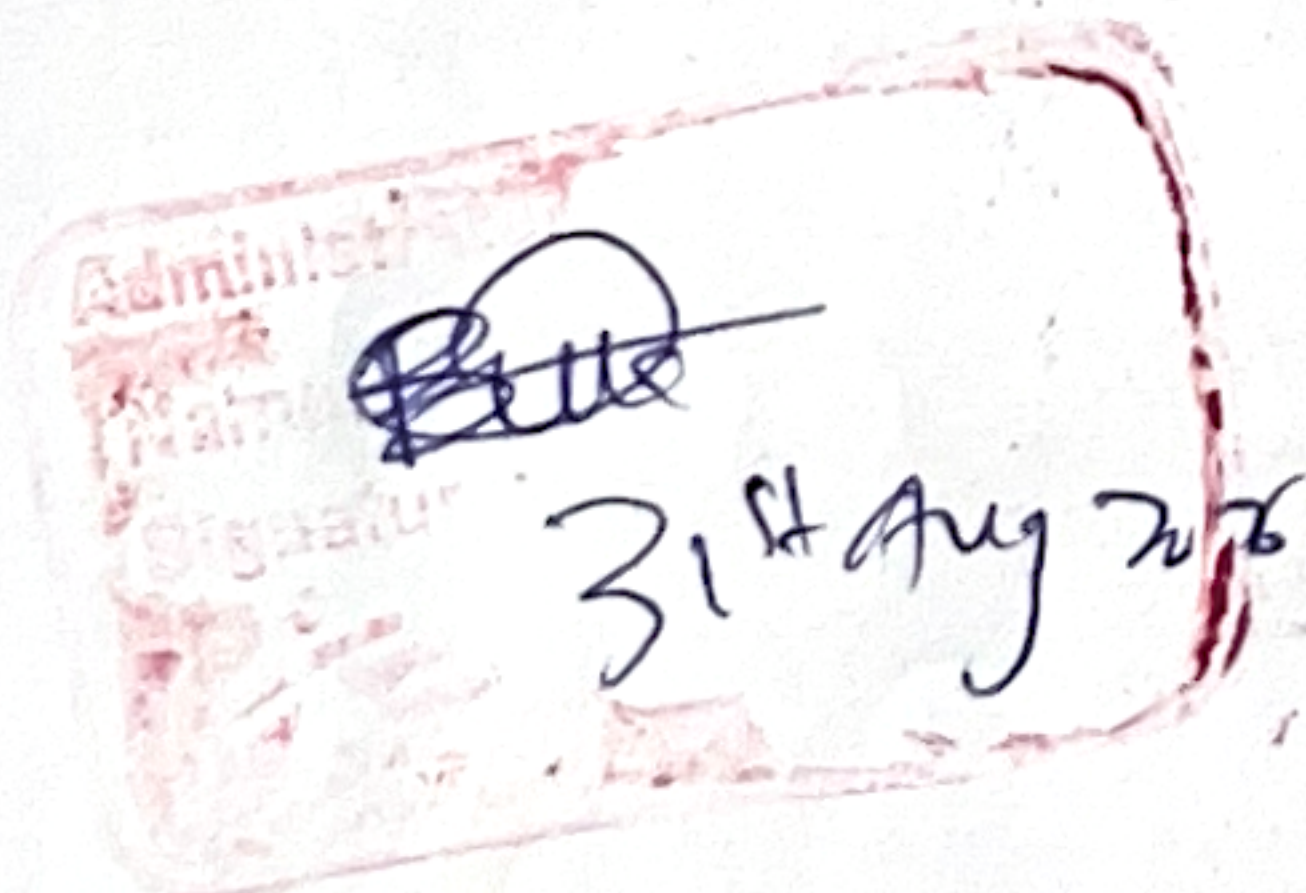
