Summary of the Position

To ensure the delivery of quality Food Security and Livelihood intervention in line with WFSSF and other government institutions and accepted humanitarian standards

The purpose of this position is to provide support to WFSS Foundation projects in handling resilience and sustainable food security and livelihood activities; in coordination with partners, including NGOs/UN agencies and government institutions

Key Responsibilities

- Liaise with external technical actors/clusters involved in the response to food insecurity and the humanitarian actors operating in the area of operation
- Liaises with National EFSL advisor.
- Contribute to and influence the development of the contingency plan and facilitate the programme operational implementation.
- Participate in the reporting to donors on the current grants and participate in the research of new grants (technical design of response, proposal writing).
- Work closely and build the EFSL capacities of local partners if required
- Ensure that gender and protection is mainstreamed in the response
- Coordination of the program in Juba & Wau with the field members of staff
- Partner with the project teams/managers/ Provide technical guidance / support to the Food Security team on the integration of agribusiness in the Food and Nutrition Security project.
- Participate in the development of business guidelines, VSLA approach, design, and implementation of income generation activities.]
- Lead and participate in household assessments, monitoring and market and value-chain studies to be conducted within the project implementation.
- Design and give specific training, workshops, and thematic events in agribusiness to other team members and to beneficiaries.
- Identifying market bottlenecks and opportunities for agricultural product value addition.

- Assist agricultural extension workers in identification of needs for the implementation of market-led production (training, equipment, agricultural inputs, etc.)
- Promote improved techniques on Post Harvest Loss Reduction and Agro-Processing.
- Participate in the design and/or implementation of activities related to the promotion of youths and returnees' engagement in the agribusiness sector.
- Maintain a non-judgmental and supportive attitude towards colleagues and beneficiaries regardless of their background.
- Take responsibility in representing WFSSF towards the local population, authorities and other INGOs or National NGOs
- Adhere and respect WFSSF guidelines and codes be a good steward by ensuring that project materials and resources are used effectively.
- Ensure that market led approaches are integrated with other activities for optimum benefit of the beneficiaries.
- Integrate nutrition trainings including appropriate cooking demonstrations to the beneficiaries of the project.
- Collaborate with practice leadership to assess needs, develop strategy and implement work plans to meet the needs of various project deliverables
- Research and gather market assessment through vendors and share it with management of the organization
- Establish strong working relationships with various stakeholders such as community leaders/RRC, beneficiaries and the donors.
- Providing on-site training services in the field across the regions where Water for South Sudan foundation is implementation some projects.
- Evaluate training feedback to monitor and improve effectiveness and make any necessary adjustments to training programs

4. Project management and implementation

- Represent WFSSF in meetings, giving talks and presentations when requested line manager.
- Plan and conduct annual needs assessments for each project site, according to WFSS standards and guidelines.
- Providing innovative and educated solutions to WFSS management regarding the training, assessment needs, curriculum design, and program evaluation
- Researching and developing innovative training approaches specifically for the targeted audiences of the work norms and beneficiary's safety

5. Financial management and Administration

- Assist the Program Manager in ensuring that projects have enough funding for their implementation.
- Provide guidance on financial records that include request for Juba office cash
- Ensure compliance with financial policies are adhere to including project staff trainings

- Manage relationships between WFSS and relevant government institutions
- Develop and maintain good relationships and lines of communication with relevant local authorities and communities prior to intervention
