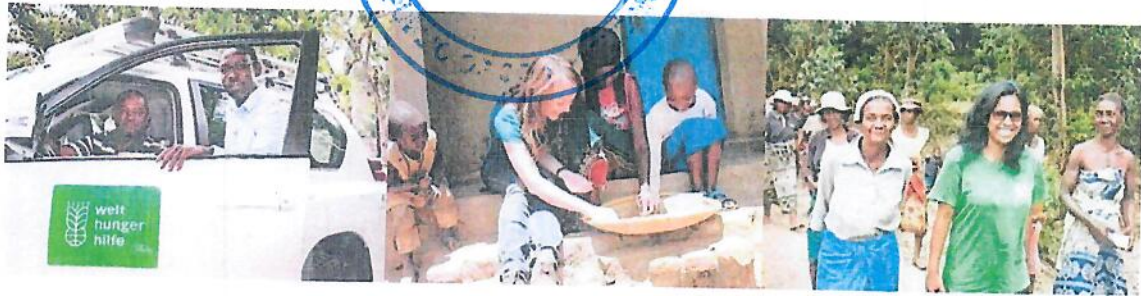

Background:

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) has been working in today's South Sudan since the late 1990's. Since the country's independence in 2011, Welthungerhilfe has implemented 87 projects ranging from rapid disaster relief to reconstruction and long-term development cooperation projects with local partners, with an overall volume of over EUR 420 million. Through 26 projects in five states (Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Unity State, Western, Central and Eastern Equatoria), we supported 774,000 people in 2022 alone. Welthungerhilfe receives institutional grants from German federal funds (GFFO, BMZ, GIZ), UN (WFP, FAO, SSHF) and the European Trust Fund (EUTF). WHH SSD primary areas of work in South Sudan are food security, agriculture, food systems, nutrition, WASH and infrastructure rehabilitation, under the overarching umbrella of climate resilience and adaptation. Established in Germany in 1962 under FAO-led campaign against hunger, currently operates in 36 countries globally.

Job purpose:

The aims of the MEAL Coordinator position are to contribute to/ lead the implementation of MEAL systems, ensuring quality assurance, compliance and use of data generated through the systems. The position holder will support the rollout of accountability, documenting and sharing learning from accountability implementation and reflection.

The MEAL Coordinator reports directly to MEAL Manager, closely coordinates with field MEAL Officers and Heads of Projects, provides technical support to MEAL Officers in all Country Project locations. The position requires regular visits to Project locations.





Key responsibilities:

- Support the implementation of monitoring, evaluation, accountability and learning Framework within WHH SSD Program.
- Monitor the implementation of project specific MEAL plans and provide necessary technical support in consultation with MEAL Manager.
- Provide leadership in most field data collection exercises and data collection and management including orienting project staff, volunteers and contractors on different MEAL tools and guidelines.
- Perform analysis of quantitative and qualitative data with support from the MEAL Manager, develop preliminary reports and share findings in an appropriate format with the project team and the MEAL Manager.
- Provide guidance to field staff in documenting human impact stories including supporting photographs, adhering to data protection policies and standards.
- Support compliance coordinator by providing participants complaints and feedback and the use of CRM tracker.
- Collaborate with HoPs and MEAL Officers to identify key project lessons, challenges and opportunities and document them well.
- Participate in project specific review meeting and document key learnings.
- Coordinate and or organize the necessary data needed for sector specific reporting (Food Security and Livelihoods (FSL) and Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)).

Your profile:

- A university degree/ diploma in Agribusiness, Management, Economic Development, Development Studies, Social Work and Social Administration, Community Development works, Statistics or equivalent qualifications that are commensurate with this position.
- Minimum of three years' experience in humanitarian and/ or development work in a similar role with a reputable NGO or government institution
- Experience working with Project MEAL systems and standards.
- Sector experience in monitoring and evaluating Gender and Protection, WASH, Food security, Economic recovery and Nutrition projects.
- Knowledge of qualitative and quantitative methods of data management.
- Proven ability to train, lead and supervise MEAL Officers, and Enumerators on data collection processes.
- Ability and familiarity with digital/electronic data collection applications such as Akvo flow, Comcare and mWater.
- Experience and ability to conduct data analysis using statistical software such as SPSS, Excel and PowerBI.
- Experience in implementing or rolling out accountability approaches like Complaint and feedback mechanisms (CRM) is desired.
- Excellent command of English (written and spoken); Arabic and other South Sudan local languages (spoken) is required.
- Flexibility and willingness to learn and work in new environments, in a team and independently.
- Ability and willingness to travel to WHH project locations.



- Excellent spoken and written English. Knowledge of Arabic and local languages is an asset.
