Background

Community in Need Aid (CINA) is a National NGO working in South Sudan, based in Juba and mandated to save lives, protect dignity and develop resilience of children and families from effects of conflicts and disasters. CINA has been working in Jonglei, Upper Nile, GPAA, Central, Eastern and Western Equatoria, Western Bahr El Ghazal and Lakes States since 2011. To effectively achieve its programme objectives, CINA is therefore seeking to recruit highly competent, proactive and self-driven person to fill the position of FSL Livelihoods Officer to be based in Nasir, Upper Nile State.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

To plan, implement, monitor and document all the FSL activities within Nasir (Koat, Kuerenge, Maker and Nasir) as per the activity's description. Provide necessary agricultural, fisheries and post-harvest related training, follow-up, monitoring technical support and guidance to farmers in the project intervention areas.

Program Management and Coordination





- Be-in charge of the all the agriculture related activities in the project
- Train the selected groups and community members on the various recommended practices for improved agronomic practices
- Organize farmers field days on suitable farming techniques where other farmers can learn from
- Develop a demonstration farms or plots for farmer field day
- Coordinate all agriculture extension activities within the project area as may be required by the project detailed implementation plan (timely and responsibly)
- Attend and organize agriculture related stakeholders' forum and meetings
- Take good care of the organization's asset/equipment under your custody at any time e.g motorbike, computers
- Organize and implement FSL activities within the project period and write timely and accurate reports including farmer training in crops rotation, vegetable gardening, water catchment, soil erosion and climate change.
- In consultation with the Cross Cutting Project Manager, develop a detailed work (action) plans for project ensuring objectives and targets are achieved.
- Liaise with government staff in identifying farmer training needs and providing on-site training;
- Coordinate with CINA HQ office on supplies to the field for project activities;
- Coordinate with project team to provide different programme reports which will include the weekly/activity reports, monthly monitoring reports and the quarterly reports as required by management, donors and partners;
- Attain and maintain optimal working relationship with partners; beneficiaries, government, partner NGOs etc;
- Coordinate all extension activities within the area as may be required by the Cross Cutting Project Manager or designee;
- Provide information for project audits as required
- Liaise with the M&E Manager in the development of the M&E Framework for effective track on project progress during monitoring and evaluation visits.
- Support the implementation of the project baseline, assessments and End of Project evaluations
- Any other duty as assigned by the supervisor/designate.
