Purpose of the position:

The purpose of this position is to provide overall leadership of all and providing technical support to WASH team. The WASH Officer will have responsibility for day to day implementation of the SSHF WASH programs and provide an oversight of WASH program to ensuring they achieve results-based on set outputs and outcomes, reporting, and compliance with donor standards and regulations. He/she will play a key role in supporting and building capacity of WASH project Staffs and other relevant stakeholders.

The position will have key responsibilities of ensuring high quality implementation of project activities, grant management according to donor requirement.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Providing advice and support on technical WASH Component
- Planning and implementation of hygiene promotion training and practical activities for IDPs, primary schools' students and staff.
- Coordinate hygiene, sanitation and community participation activities of the organization with line departments (county Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Officer, RRC etc.)
- Planning and implementation of water management and hand-pump care takers trainings and supervision of water management committees.
- Monitoring access to water and water quality testing through regular water quality analysis and ensure disinfection of any water sources which show contamination
- Design and supervision of boreholes and water yard points, latrines, solid waste pit construction and rehabilitation



- Supervise all the WASH hardware constructions ensuring that they are done following World Vision International guidelines.
- Facilitation community hygiene promotion through community meetings, in schools, health facilities, campaigns, radio program and social occasions.
- Conduct campaigns in the IPDs sites on emergency construction of pit latrines and seeking always for the maximum involvement of the community.
- Coordinate with the department of public utility, the relevant authorities, the cluster agencies and community leaders for the involvement of all stakeholders and sustainable of the program.
- Regular monitoring and follow up of partners to ensure the proper implementation of planned activities by coordinating with the field office.
- Perform any other program or operations duty assigned by the WASH Project Manager

Knowledge/Qualifications for the Role.

- At least 3 years of hands on experience in implementation of emergency WASH programmes in conflict settings.
- Experience in WASH officer or higher position is added advantages.
- Prior training and experience in WASH related fields, Hygiene promotion, Bore hole drilling and rehabilitation is a must: proficiency.
- Technical experience in Computer sketching and BOQ designing is a must.
- Computer Skills advanced in Microsoft Excel and word is preferred.
- University degree in Engineering architecture or any Degree related to WASH is preferable.
- Degree in public health community development is also preferred.
- Computer literate especially Microsoft word, excel and power point.
