1 Overview

Peace Canal is seeking an exceptional candidate to provide management oversight of organisational peacebuilding work in Jonglei/GPAA and Lakes states.

The purpose of the Peacebuilding Manager role is to manage and support key project personnel based in project locations, implement approved budgets and activities, ensure timely donor reporting, and work collaboratively with other senior managers within the organisation

- Work collaboratively with other senior managers within the organisation
- Establish an effective filing system (physical and online) which can provide easy access to information and proper documentation of all financial requirement.

5 Candidates


The position is open to national candidates, and the candidate shall be based in Juba with 30% visits to the field locations.
