Job Summary

Under the supervision of the Project Officer, the Field team leader will provide leadership to Hold the Child's SCOPE enrolment team as would be assigned through the various counties of Jonglei

Duties & Accountabilities

- Promote organization mission and values at all level and adhere to the UN (Humanitarian) code of conduct; mindful of Hold the Child policies and standard operation procedures (SOPs).
- Ensure updated team schedules in collaboration with the project officer
- Ensure safe team deployment in compliance to adopted SCOPE enrolment schedules
- Ensure team supplies are in preparation for deployment, working with the project officer and the operations associate
- Ensure team compliance to SCOPE identification and enrolment standards,
- Hold team planning and progress evaluation sessions and timely share minutes with project officer to any additional support as the needs would arise
- Ensure health working relations with outreach hosting communities and partners
- Ensure weekly data transmission and site enrolments are completed by the team (social mobilizers and ICT assistants)
- Ensure compliance to the Hold the Child's adopted Complaint, Referral, Tracking, and Feedback, Mechanism (CRTFM) across operated outreach sites
- Adhere to codes of conduct in all activities (e.g., UN Code of Conduct for the prevention of sexual exploitation and abuse and Hold the Child, Child Protection Policy), needs of

vulnerable people, violations of human rights, child rights and women's rights (i.e., international conventions), and reporting mechanisms.
