Job Purpose

The Medical Logistician is responsible for the process of planning, implementing, managing and controlling all activities involved in sourcing, procurement, distribution, and logistics management of all pharmaceutical (including laboratory supplies and medical supplies) for Amref - CCM Foundation within the area of operation. He/she is also responsible for providing technical assistance and capacity building in health commodities forecasting, quantification, ordering, storage and use across all supported health facilities, in close collaboration with the County Health Departments and technical team.

He/she will report to the Lot Coordinator and collaborate with the Procurement and Logistics Coordinator for the effective management and coordination of pharmaceutical procurement- and logistics-related activities in the country.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Strengthen commodity (pharmaceutical and laboratory) logistics management, information management and tracking;
- Organize and ensure the standardization of order, procurement, transportation and delivery management; Ensure compliance with Amref – CCM Foundation and donor procurement drug policies and regulations;
- Develop and maintain databases for all relevant sites, commodities, reporting, and supervision at all levels;

 Support the Lot Coordinator and the Procurement and Logistics Coordinator in the development and management of tenders and contracts as appropriate;

- Fluency in written and spoken English knowledge of Dinka, Bongo language and Arabic is an asset.
