

## **JOB VACANCY – PHYSIOTHERAPIST (BACK-UP) POOL**

MSF Switzerland (MSF-CH) is currently seeking to employ a qualified candidate for the following position, will be put on back-up list and could be contacted in case of need.

**Position: Physiotherapist**

**Location: Abyei Special Administrative Area**

### **Scope of responsibilities:**

Following medical prescription, plan and carry out individual treatment programmes, by assessing patients' physical state, in order to maintain, improve or rehabilitate the physical well-being of the patient and prevent physical handicaps.

### **Main tasks**

- **Assess patient physical capacities, using different procedures (e.g. functional capacity tests) to set up treatment objectives with the patient and therefore improve patient's health and wellbeing. Elaborate and implement physiotherapy programs, including physiotherapy exercises, manipulations, massages, education, utilization of physiotherapy devices and orthopedic equipment, educating and advising patients and their careers on how to prevent and/or improve conditions, to accelerate and improve activity results.**
- **Train patients and caretakers on how to avoid injury to create preventive behaviors.**
- **Actively monitor and report physiotherapy activities (correctly filling in patient files, forms, statistics, and reports) and analyze these statistics to improve quality service, preserving patient's data traceability.**
- **Take care of physiotherapy equipment, managing stock, making orders according to activity and cleaning up the equipment, to ensure its continuous availability and quality of service.**
- **Report to the technical reference for any problem arising in the service, especially the loss/robbery/damage of medical equipment or medicines to implement the appropriate measures.**

### **Recruitment criteria**

<b>Education</b>	Essential, Physiotherapist official degree/diploma.
<b>Experience</b>	Not required. (the one from the study period is considered as an experience)
<b>Languages</b>	Essential, local language; desirable, mission working language.
<b>Competencies</b>	Results, teamwork, flexibility, commitment, service

South Sudanese candidates who meet the above criteria are invited to apply through the below link using a computer or a QR code on their smartphone. Candidates who do not have access to the internet may submit their application at the MSF Switzerland office in Abyei, Ameth Bekh Hospital. Application documents include cover letter, CV, relevant AND VALID copy of diploma or degree, work certificates, and other documents such as national ID, residence and labour card.
