Objective of the positions

CBID and HA coordinator provides high-level oversight, strategic guidance and technical support to DAHW CBID and HA Programs/Projects. The ultimate goal of the position is to manage and grow the organization's CBID and HA program and fundraising portfolic, to increase the quality, efficiency and long-term impact of the program; and to promote and advocate for sustained high-level engagement of government and civil society. The position requires travel within South Sudan.

## Main RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the development and implementation of CBID and HA strategy for DAHW disability and rehabilitation activities in South Sudan;
- Responsible for developing plans for South Sudan Program office aimed at the disability and rehabilitation and promotion of inclusion, and Humanitarian Aid;
- Responsible to oversee the whole project cycle of GLRA South Sudan Program office CBID and HA projects (conceptualization, planning, design, implementation and evaluation) and to ensure high technical quality and adherence to GLRA and/or donor-related standards during all stages.
- Responsible to ensure that the CBID /HA programs adhere to GLRA's safeguarding policies:
- Responsible for the identification of important gaps in Disability, Rehabilitation, and Humanitarian Crisis and to urge for the exploration and utilization of untapped opportunities in South Sudan:
- Pro-actively seek for new alliances, strategies, networking and partnerships in close co-operation with Head of program and Regional Office;

- Facilitate the planning of interdisciplinary and multi-sectoral programs through adequate design and the identification of suitable partner organizations (working on relevant sectors)
- Supervise (through regular meeting and regular report analysis) all CBID and HA
  Projects activities supported by DAHW and give feedback to projects/partners and
  advice on adaptation of activities according to the set indicators.
- Responsible for identifying CBID and HA related grant funding and develop grant proposals;
- Responsible for implementing, monitoring, Supervising, reporting and evaluations of CBID and HA Projects in South Sudan
- Identify best practices and lessons learned in the field of CBID and HA and share those with Head of Program and Regional office
- Assist in the capacity building process (based on identified training needs) among GLRA staff, partner organizations, DPOs etc., to ensure a good level of expertise on GLRA's mandates (CBID, HA, etc.)
