Our core mission is to promote enterprising culture and self-reliance to uphold social goal, transformation, and development initiatives in the country. To realize this revelation, we apply a participatory development approach as tool to drive innovation and creativity to support a wide array of economic and social human development initiatives which contribute to the creation of opportunities for the benefit of poor and disadvantaged individuals and groups in community.</p> <p>We specialize in Grants Management and Technical Assistance, Entrepreneurship and Microenterprise Development, Agriculture and Sustainable Livelihoods, Off-grid and Renewable Energy, Youth Mentorship and Skill Development, Water, Sanitation and Hygiene, Health and Social Development, Education and Functional Literacy, Community Telecenter and Information Technology, Community Peace and Mediation and Research and Development. Set against these challenges, we are ramming up effort to develop a <u>5-year Resource Mobilization Strategy</u> to enable us to navigate through complexity of the unpredictable world of the new normal created by the Covid-19 pandemic and its associated challenges.</p> <p>The overall objective of the <u>Resource Mobilization Strategy</u> is to establish a clear, systematic, predictable, and coordinated approach for FYI to soliciting, acquiring, and utilization, management, reporting, monitoring, and evaluating assistance from prospective partners and to ensure sustainable resources are available for implementation of development programs in the country.</p> <p>It is in this context that this request for proposal (RFP) is situated, which aims to recruit the services of an expert to develop <u>a Resource Mobilization Strategy</u>, which will outline a coordinated innovative approach, develop a resource generating tools and profile a network of government institutions, regional corporations, embassies, multinational corporations, international NGOs, registered investment advisors, family offices, endowments and foundations to which fundraising will be channeled tying to FYI’s strategic plan’s budget.</p> <p>This scope of work will be based on the analysis of the current situation of the NGOs industry in South Sudan, desk review of policy documents and other research works which are available in public domain to develop a 5-year comprehensive <u>Resource Mobilization Strategy</u> adapted to</p>
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	the programmatic activity of Foundation for Youth Initiative.
Purpose and Objectives	The overall objective of this RFP is to recruit the services of an expert to develop a resource mobilization strategy. The blueprint will be developed in a way that provides Foundation for Youth Initiative with a clear, systematic, predictable, and coordinated approach to soliciting, acquiring, and utilization, management, reporting, monitoring, and evaluating assistance from prospective partners and for expanding the resource base to ensure sustainable resources are available for implementation of the FYI's development programs in the country.
