The Position

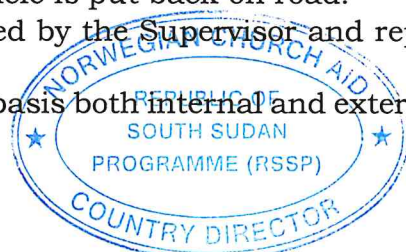
NCA is looking for a suitably qualified and experienced candidate to fill the position of **Driver/Mechanic** based in Juba Central Equatoria 00000000State.

Areas of Responsibility

- Ensure safe driving of all NCA staff.
- Inspect the vehicles assigned to him or her on regular basis and report any fault detected to the Supervisor.
- Adhere to NCA security and safety rules and regulations while driving.
- Ensure the vehicle is kept clean and no poisonous substance is kept in the vehicle.
- Adhere to traffic rules and regulations.
- Ensure compliance to Covid-19 protocols set out by the South Sudan government and NCA

Main Tasks

- Facilitate the movement of NCA staff during working hours.
- Pick and drop staff from/to their residence in the morning and evening during the week.
- Inspect the vehicle assigned to him/her every morning and ensure any fault detected is rectified before the vehicle is put back on road.
- Fill the logbooks for vehicle as instructed by the Supervisor and report expiry of the same.
- Clean the vehicle thoroughly on weekly basis both internal and external.



- Obey traffic rules and regulations, and NCA safety regulations while driving.
- Detect any fault with the vehicle, diagnose it and fix the problems
- Carry out vehicle service(s) and repairs both level 1 and level 2 which may include changing of all the vehicle oils and fluids, brake repair, ignition systems , replacement of gaskets, repair and replacement of clutch plates, repair and replacement of tyres, amongst others.
- Report any maintenance issues to the Logistics, without delay.

Educational Qualifications, Experience and Skills

- A minimum of two years of working experience with a non-Governmental Organization
- Recognized and valid South Sudan driving certificate/licence is required.
- Has acquired formal training in motor mechanic
- Fluency in both spoken and written English and basic Arabic is required.
- Ability and flexibility to understand the cultural, political environment and working well with local authorities.
- Willingness to live and, work in remote and isolated areas.
