TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BIDDING.

3.5.1 Scoring Evaluation

Trade-Off Method

Coalition for Humanity Tender Committee will conduct a technical evaluation which will grade technical criteria on a weighted basis (each criteria is given a percentage, all together equalling 100%). Offeror's proposals should consist of all required technical submittals so Coalition for Humanity committee can thoroughly evaluate the technical criteria listed herein and assign points based on the strength of a technical submission.

Award criteria shall be based on the proposal/Quotation's overall **"value for money"** (quality, cost, delivery time, etc.) while taking into consideration donor and internal requirements and regulations. Each individual criteria have been assigned a weighting prior to the release of this RFQ based on its importance to Coalition for Humanity in this process. Offeror (s) with the best score will be accepted as the winning offered(s), assuming the price is deemed fair and reasonable and subject to the additional due diligence in [section 3.5.2](#).



When performing the Scoring Evaluation, the Coalition for Humanity tender committee will assign points for each criteria based on the following scale:

Point	Rationale
0	Not acceptable; has not met any part of the specified criteria
1-4	Has met only some minimum requirements and may not be acceptable
5	Acceptable
6-9	Acceptable; has met all requirements and exceeds some
10	Acceptable; has exceeded all requirements

3.5.2 Additional Due Diligence

Upon completion of both the technical and financial evaluations Coalition for Humanity may choose to engage in additional due diligence processes with a particular supplier or supplier(s). The purpose of these processes is to ensure that Coalition for Humanity engages with reputable, ethical, responsible Suppliers with solid financials and the ability to fulfil the contract. Additional due diligence may take the form of the following processes (though it is not limited to):

- Reference Checks
- Supplier's facility visits
- Analysis of audited financial statements



- Determination of relations and affiliations between offerors
- Reference check with clients who have received similar services from the offeror



Important terms and conditions.

1. Price offer Currency -USD and Mode of payment
2. The per-qualified/eligible suppliers acknowledge RFQ by (sign/stamped/date) on the second copy from the supplier.
3. **Delivery time frame and location of delivery: We prefer delivery done to Aweil West County but should you wish to quote for items and delivery option is Juba, please indicate the number of days you require for either delivery to Juba or Aweil West. (Preference shall be given to supplier delivering to Aweil West)**
4. **Seed certification: The supplier should attach a certificate proving that it has been prequalified by the Ministry of Agriculture and food security in South Sudan and provides certified seeds.**
5. Validity of the offer should be minimum of 60 Days
6. Payment shall be within 30 working days after receipt of goods and invoice, by cheque or transfer.
7. subject to VAT; therefore, all offers should be exclusive of VAT costs.
