JOB VACANCY – ANAESTHETIST NURSE

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, humanitarian, non-governmental organisation providing assistance to people in need as a result of natural and man-made disasters, irrespective of race, religion, ideology or politics.

MSF Switzerland (MSF-CH) is currently seeking to employ a qualified candidate for the following position for short term contract.

Position: Anaesthetist Nurse

Number of Vacancies: (Back-Up Pool)

Location: Abyei Administrative Area_ Ameth Bek Hospital

Scope of responsibilities:

Performing all anaesthetic medical activities according to MSF policies, protocols and universal hygiene standards, to ensure the quality of pre, during and post-operative care of patients.

Main tasks:

- In collaboration with the Anaesthetist Dr, performing anaesthetic consultations to patients due for surgery, evaluating of the risks of operating and anaesthesia (with the surgeon), check patient's written authorization for their operation, providing patients with appropriate information on their illness and treatments, and deciding on what type of anaesthetics to be used, performing sedation, general anaesthesia with and without intubation, and LMA insertion.
- According to set procedures, carrying out all nursing anaesthetics related activities during surgery to collaborate in patient's adequate anaesthetized state and safety during the process. Filing the anaesthesia and surgical safety checklist, Preparing the drugs, material, and equipment required for the surgery. Monitoring patients throughout the whole intervention and administering and maintaining anaesthetics following the rules of hygiene and asepsis in force, and newborn resuscitation.
- Providing post-operative care, including immediate post-operative surveillance in the recovery room and special patients present in the intensive care unit, to adapt the prescriptions, with special focus on patient's pain relief assessment and treatment, fluid management and deep venous thrombosis prevention during the stabilization and recovery process.
- Respecting, promoting and ensuring medical confidentiality and implementing and following IPC and hygiene rules, procedures and protocols always as well as looking after the integrity of anaesthesia material (decontamination, sterilization, storage conditions, etc.) and other equipment, to ensure the safety and protection of patients and other staff. Knowing accidental blood exposure policy and procedure and implementing them when necessary.
- Ensuring cleaning and minor maintenance tasks are performed according to the protocols for re-usable anaesthesia material. Reporting any malfunction to the project biomedical service.
- Carrying out all pharmacy related activities (stock control, station's re-stocking, inventories, expired drugs, etc.) and other equipment of anaesthetic ward, doing special follow-up of narcotics and sedatives (register, consumptions, empty phials, etc.), ensuring enough stock-up and the good functioning to carry-out the medical activities. Drawing up pharmacy orders according to needs.
- Collaborating with other departments and supporting other medical services to support the overall MSF project with his/her expertise and capabilities. Training of recovery-room nurses on post anaesthesia monitoring and working particularly in close collaboration with the emergency department and midwifery and obstetrics team in the maternity department (especially to resuscitate new-borns).
- In case of mass casualty incident, collaborate with the team particularly in the red zone for damage control resuscitation of red patients and prioritize patients to be taken first in the operative room depending on their clinical condition.
- Carrying out administrative procedures and documents (fill in of patient's files, forms, statistics, data base, etc.), to have updated and correct information about the day-to-day activities.
- Drawing up and sending out reports for the monthly follow up of peri-surgical mortality and for the quality of anaesthesia/pain management and informing the direct supervisor immediately in the event of medical error.

- Nursing diploma with specialisation as anaesthetics nurse is essential. Desired Bachelor or Diploma in Nursing. Valid registration.
- Experience:**
- Essential 2 years of previous supervised work experience as an anesthetist nurse

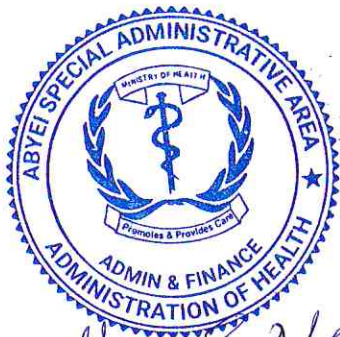
