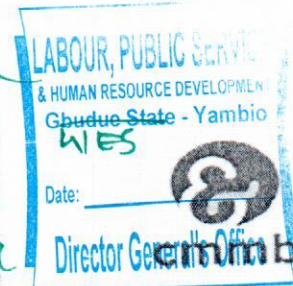

Main Objective

The Nutrition Officer is responsible for implementing and supervising emergency nutrition activities in the field, in adherence with CMMB and national protocols/guidelines, and in collaboration with State Ministry of Health. S/he reports to Project Manager at field level. The activities under emergency nutrition project include:

- Community based Management of Acute Malnutrition (CMAM) approach
- Assessments and surveillance interventions (nutrition surveys using ENA for SMART, coverage surveys, sentinel site, LQAS etc)
- Capacity building of local partners
- Community mobilization

Responsibilities

- Team management including staff recruitment, training, evaluation.
- Provision of continuous guidance and technical support.
- Monitoring of emergency nutrition project activities (field visit, regular project monitoring, budget forecast and follow up, statistics follow up report, etc.)
- Reporting (donors reports, monthly reports).
- Representation of CMMB in coordination meeting with local and National partners, health authorities, etc.
- Coordination with other sectors at the state level and national (food security and livelihood, Water Sanitation and Hygiene and logistics).

Qualifications

Applications shall not be considered from candidates who do not possess ALL the Essential Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Public health and Nutrition desired or; Bachelor's degree in nursing with at least 3 years relevant work experience and extensive practical management experience preferably in emergency nutrition and humanitarian response programmes.
- Experience of managing the programme cycle, including assessments, project design, proposal and report writing, implementation, monitoring and evaluation;
- Strong results orientation, with the ability to challenge existing mindsets
- Experience of managing large and diverse teams in resource-poor, insecure settings.
- Excellent planning, coordination, and reporting skills, with the ability to organize a substantial workload comprised of complex, diverse tasks and responsibilities;
- Strong analytical, monitoring and evaluation, and report-writing abilities; Have technical background and knowledge in CMAM/MIYCN and demonstrated work experience in implementing CMAM components and hygiene promotion/Nutrition education programs; 2 to 3 years' experience in Management of emergency nutrition; NGO & refugee camp setting experience preferred.
