Based on the knowledge of the local context and circumstances, TITI foundation as Women Led organization has muscled its experience in implementing development work in fragile and complex environments that address the multiple challenges to growth in region, for women's Economic empowerment and Market Development.

SUMMARY

Titi foundation is implementing an emergency response project in Eleven Payams in Aweil East and Aweil North counties which is aimed at responding to the refugee crisis caused by the high numbers of refugees entering South Sudan as they flee from the Sudan crisis.

Through this project, Titi Foundation will distribute Non-food items to individuals that are seriously affected and vulnerable in the Eleven payams Aweil East and Aweil North.

The priority is persons with disability, pregnant and lactating women, children headed households, women headed households, chronically ill persons, and the elderly people.

Service Provider's obligations:

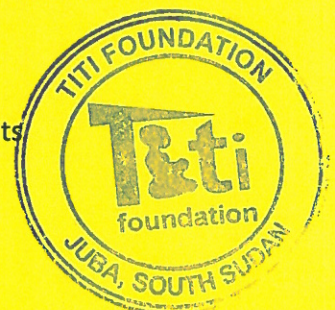
The supplier is required to deliver the items in Aweil Centre (Titi Foundation store) 2 weeks before the distribution dates. All good will be inspected and any broken/damaged/poor quality item will need to be replaced within 3 days after inspection

Required goods**Lot 1. Food items**

- a. Rice – 5kgs, 10kgs, 25Kgs – 500units
- b. Cooking Oil – 1litre, 3litre, 5litre – 500units
- c. Salt – 500gms – 500units
- d. Flour – 5Kgs, 10Kgs, 20Kgs, 30Kgs – 500Units

Lot 2. Non-food items {Tarpaulin, Bucket, soap, mosquito net and blanket} – 500units**Lot 3. Dignity Kits (IRC standard, UNICEF standard) – 1,200 units****Lot 4. Seeds and tools assorted.**

- a. Hoes, slashers, rake – 300Units
- b. Fast maturing vegetable seeds – Various – 300Units



NB. Each lot **MUST** be applied separately.

Qualifications/Submission documents:

Titi Foundation South Sudan will consider the following minimum attributes of the service provider;

1. At least 2 years of experience in providing cash disbursements/distributions.
2. Ability to provide such services across South Sudan.
3. Proven previous experience with NNGOs, INGOs, UN agencies etc. will be considered highly advantageous.

Fully registered with the Government of South Sudan and possessing valid documents at the time of submission (Valid Tax clearance and licenses).
