Overview of this Role:

This position will oversee Pharmaceutical and Medical supply chain at the field level while ensuring rationale use of medicines with the emergency response. Importantly he/she will be able to maintain proper records of medicals supplies received from various donors supporting the response and provide full accountability on their consumption

RESPONSIBILITIES / DUTIES

- To uphold internal values and to contribute to the wellbeing of the team as an active member.
- Supervise all dispensers and ensure that medicines are dispensed appropriately observing all the RIGHTs of rationale prescription.
- Update the clinical team on availability, near expiries and stockout of medical supplies with recommended alternatives regularly
- Keep proper records of all medical supplies received by donor
- Compiles all the consumption report and share with the Lot pharmacist for review
- Prepares and issues all the requests for medicines made by the clinical team

- Check that doses prescribed are correct to guidelines and inform Clinic in Charge of any discrepancies
- Liaise with the logistic officer to complete month GIK reports for the County.
- Ensure medication is correctly and clearly marked
- Ensure the pharmacy is locked securely if no staff is present.
- Ensure the pharmacy and equipment are clean and that medicines are arranged in FEFO and FIFO criteria.
- Ensure all medications are kept in proper conditions and are used within expiry dates where feasible support to rotate supplies between facilities and projects.
- Ensure adequate stock of medications and supplies
- Liaise with clinic staff to compile a single stock request and inventory weekly for the clinic
- Ensure weekly consumption report is completed and submitted
- Accurately track the dispensing of all medications
- Other duties as requested by line manager

QUALIFICATIONS AND JOB REQUIREMENTS

- Diploma in pharmacy, Diploma in Nursing and clinical medicine with experience in managing medical supply chain can be considered.
- At least 1 year experience working in Health and Nutrition program / health facility set up - clinic or hospital.
- Fluent in written and spoken English.
- Fluent in Arabic and at least a local language
- Experience working in refugee settings in South Sudan
- Previous experience working in a multi-cultural set up an added advantage.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
