

- Provide technical direction, leadership and training to the community structures/CBOs/beneficiaries on CBPP (Community Based Participator Planning), i.e. Asset/Project selection, business planning, income

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- generation, group savings and loans, revolving funds, vocational skills training and strengthening of small-scale businesses for the beneficiaries to enhance their self-reliance, etc.
- Participating in proposals development review and budgeting for new projects/extension in accordance with the provided guidelines and standards
- Responsible for overseeing implementation of CDD activities in accordance with approved time schedules and budgets.
- Responsible for promoting and facilitating selected eligibale host community youths participation in business planning, skills course activities etc.
- Responsible for strengthening synergies of the AAH Core Competences with regards to CDD.
- Represent AAH in SSLRP/IFAD meetings in the Country/Juba and all project locations/counties.
- Report on protection issues observed in the course of implementation of AAH projects in South Sudan.
