This position requires a deep understanding of USAID Programming in Education and Youth development, focusing on enhancing literacy, numeracy, soft skills, and technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) The Education and Youth Specialist shall report to the Evaluation Team Lead. This is a short-term position, and it will be from January 2025 – March 2025.

- Provide in-depth analysis and insights into education and youth development strategies, particularly literacy, numeracy, soft skills and TVET.
- Evaluate the alignment of YEA's educational initiatives with USAID's strategic goals and objectives.
- Design and implement data collection tools tailored to assess educational outcomes and impacts on youth development
- Conduct comprehensive fieldwork, including interviews, focus groups, and site visits, to gather robust qualitative and quantitative data
- Collaborate with YEA stakeholders, including civil society organization, youth's corps, and youth
 organizations, to gather diverse perspectives and feedback.
- Lead workshops and discussions to validate findings and refine recommendations
- Contribute to the evaluation report by providing detailed, evidence-based analysis and actionable education and youth development recommendations.
