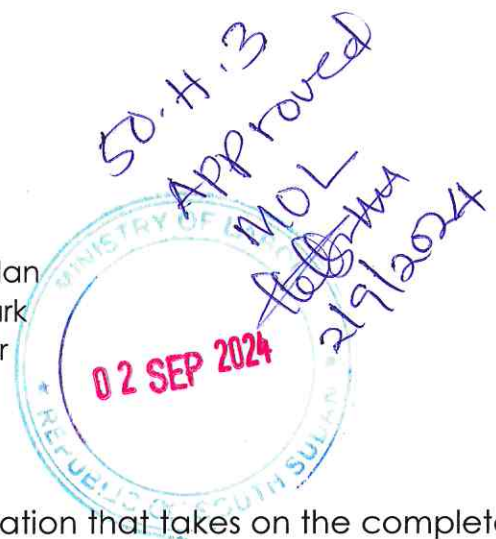

BACKGROUND:

African Parks is a non-profit conservation organization that takes on the complete responsibility for the rehabilitation and long-term management of national parks in partnership with governments and local communities. We currently manage 22 national parks and protected areas in 12 countries covering over 20 million hectares in: Angola, Benin, Central African Republic, Chad, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Malawi, Mozambique, Republic of Congo, Rwanda, Zambia, Zimbabwe and South Sudan.

Boma and Bandingilo National Parks are located in South Sudan’s equatorial region with a combined area of 30, 000 KM ². The parks host the largest wildlife migration in Africa that covers over 120,000 KM², and provides habitat for large populations of white eared kob, tiang, mongalla gazelle and bohor reedbuck.

JOB OVERVIEW:

The Welder will be responsible for performing welding tasks to support the construction and maintenance needs of the project. This includes welding and fabricating metal structures and components as required.

MAIN ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform welding tasks to join, fabricate, and repair metal structures and components.
- Interpret technical drawings and blueprints to determine welding requirements.
- Maintain and care for welding equipment, ensuring it is in good working condition.
- Collaborate with other technical staff to support construction and maintenance projects.
- Adhere to safety protocols and guidelines during welding operations.
