Purpose of the position:

The position holder shall be in charge of assisting the implementation of the Stabilization center (Inpatient program) and OTP, strengthening the triage, identification, and treatment of severe acute malnourished children with medical complication in the County. S/He wills mainly assisting the weekly SC/OTP weekly implementation of the program

- The certificated nurse is overall responsible day to day activities in the SC ward to ensure the entire patient are monitored.
- Provide right treatment to SAM children with medical complications as per the ITP guideline South Sudan or WHO protocols.
- Preparation and Provision of F-100, F-75 or Plumpy nuts as per IMSAM guidelines and monitoring the caretakers are feeding the patients well.
- Recording amount of feeds taken and making sure the patient are getting enough required feeds/KCAL.
- Provide IYCF key messages to caretakers of admitted children.
- Making necessary arrangement for children not gaining weight.
- Dispense medications as prescribed by Doctor, clinical officer in SC ward.

- Advice patient's /care taker on proper use of medications
- Make sure there is enough drugs stocks in the pharmacy all the time for SC activities.
- Request medications needed from the stores on schedule (Weekly/biweekly)
- Record correctly all medications received from the stores/ dispensed and balance as per drug consumption ledger book.
- Making sure the SC ward is conducive and cleaner doing their job well

Give prescribed injections to the patients, set up drips and manage the short

- stay patients.
- Assist the clinical officer when called upon
- Countercheck the prescribed medication for any errors on doses, right medication for the right ailments and confirm with the clinical officer if in doubt.
- Check all drugs for expiry date and report accordingly.
- Keeping all records and registers for SC ward
- Compiling weekly and monthly report

Any other duties given by the supervisor

Reporting (Program/Admin/HR/Supplies/Logistics)

- Compiling weekly/monthly reports and submitting to the clinical officer
- Reporting Admin/HR related issues to the clinical officer
- Reporting (weekly/monthly) supplies and program (CMAM/MIYCN) related
- Supervision of cleanliness of the facility
- Supplies management ensuring safety and security of the nutrition supplies
- Participating in support supervision CHD/UNICEF/WFP/CARE

Supervision, training and guidance feeding assistants (NWs) Requesting supplies for the site and ensuring no stock outs

GBV

- Basic Counseling and case management enhance a survivor's ability to receive confidential, safe, and timely services that meets their needs by reporting and referral
- Participate in women and girls empowerment activities, building support networks among women/girls, and promote social integration of survivors and other vulnerable women, through community based groups e.g. mother support groups.
- Ensure proper documentation of reported GBV incidences
- Adhere to GBV guiding principles of respect, confidentiality, and safety/security and nondiscrimination while providing services to women and girls.
- Provide physical accompaniment to survivors of GBV to access other services in accordance with their wishes, choices and decisions
 - Awareness-raising activities in coordination with GBV partners

Coordination

- Attend health and nutrition facility meetings organized at the hospital and reports key issues to the nutrition assistant
- Maintain positive coordination and relationships with partner and other CARE sector staff
