1. BACKGROUND

Universal Intervention and Development Organization is a South Sudanese National and Christian organization founded in 2004. The organization is legally registered by the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC). UNIDOR is one of the Humanitarian actors, has a strong presence in the country and implementing multi-sectoral projects which are designed to alleviate severe suffering of the affected IDPs, vulnerable host communities, returnees, natural disasters and disease outbreaks. UNIDOR is a member of different clusters in the country as well as a member of the NGOs Forum, the country's humanitarian networking body. UNIDOR's main thematic focus includes Health, Nutrition, WASH, Protection, Food Security and livelihood (FSL), Education and Peace building and conflict mitigation.

Through its 7 Multi-sectoral programmes mentioned above, UNIDOR is currently, in collaboration with national, state line ministries/counterparts, local government and other humanitarian NGOs, complimenting humanitarian response to critical needs of conflict affected IDPs, vulnerable hosts, returnees in more than 10 former counties of four former states, namely Unity (Parieng, Rubkona, Koch, Mayendit, Leer and Panyijar), Lakes (Cueibet and Yirol West), Western Bahr el Ghazal (Jur River) and Warrap (Gogrial East) in South Sudan.
