- ❖ **The midwife will participate in antenatal care, labour, delivery and postnatal care in the Maternity Department in Abrouc PHCC**
- ❖ **Support the ward incharge with the day to day management of the maternity Ward**
- ❖ **Ensure patients information is documented accordingly**
- ❖ **Insure infection prevention and control measures is maintained (including disinfection, cleaning and sterilization of instruments) in the department**
- ❖ **Identify high risk pregnancies, danger signs/complications during Antenatal, Labour and postnatal and report to the doctor without delay**
- ❖ **Help out in theater producer**
- ❖ **Offering clinical management to SGBV cases referred into the unit.**
- ❖ **Provide sound family planning information and advice and administer methods available**
- ❖ **To provide curative treatment, preventive and promote health to pregnant mothers.**
- ❖ **Together with the MCHW, vaccinate pregnant and women of child bearing age.**

- ❖ Provide RH education and disease prevention message.
- ❖ Actively promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within International Medical Corps.
- ❖ Do Any other duties assigned by supervisor?
