OVERVIEW OF THE POSITION

General Description:

Support implementation of Environmental Management Systems (EMS) in WFP Country operations per corporate commitment in WFP's Environmental Policy and accompany Environmental and Social Sustainability Framework (ESSF). These efforts support WFP to systematically measure, manage and report on WFP's environmental risks, and reduce operating costs by enabling cost-effective environmental actions in WFP's facilities and operations and contribute to UN and WFP commitments to the Strategy for Sustainability Management in the United Nations system, 2020-2030 - Phase 1

Key Tasks and Responsibilities:

- 1. Lead in the roll-out of WFP Environmental Management Systems (EMS) in WFP country operations following corporate commitments in WFP's Environmental Policy and accompanying Environmental and Social Sustainability Framework of reduction of its carbon and environmental footprint.
- 2. Oversee the overall execution, mission, and efficacy of the 7 thematic areas regarding Environmental Sustainability program/projects as detailed below:
- a) **Energy:** Conduct assessments and recommend context-specific, practical energy-efficient initiatives in-country operation
- b) Waste: Support the scale-up of waste management initiatives in WFP field offices targeting waste
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reduction, recycling, reuse, and recovery where possible

- c) Water: Support the roll-out of water conservation and reuse initiatives within WFP operations areas
- d) **Wastewater**: Support wastewater management reuse/recycling initiative and monitoring within WFP operation areas
- e) **Sustainable procurement:** Support procurement/logistic unit with guidelines and measures to maintain sustainability on goods and services.
- f). **Use of hazardous substances:** Conduct assessment and provide guidelines and a roadmap of how to reduce greenhouse gases and environmental footprint within WFP operations.
- g) **Environmental training /awareness:** Conduct regular and ad-hoc environmental awareness using the best communication channel on environmental sustainability and practices.
- 3. Conduct Assessment in Country Office (Juba Area) and the field offices (15) and proposing/follow up implementation of tailored initiatives to environmental safeguarding and initiatives citing the poor infrastructure and limited resources available in the remote locations.
- 4. Collaborate with other UN agencies on the Environmental initiatives through OMT, taking the lead in exploring areas of such collaboration and ensuring that all key stakeholders internally and management are consulted/involved and required scope of EMS is captured.
- 5. Follow up and scale up already established waste management initiatives in field offices and initiate good waste management practices including environmental awareness training for staff, environmental focal points and partners.
- 6. Provide technical guidance and support to other functional units, not limited to Programme, Logistics and Engineering and identify areas of improvement/areas of initiatives, in review of the country office planned activities in both the Country Office and remote areas.
- 7. Build the capacity of the Management Services staff by guiding, coaching and mentoring EMS framework and required action plans/assessments and environmental matrixes.
